LINDA VISTA HOMES ASSOCIATION POOL RULES

- Pool and parking lot are open from 8 am to 9 pm only (consideration for the peace and privacy of the pool's immediate neighbors is requested).
- The pool area is for the use of members of the Linda Vista Homes Association and their guests only; no one should be admitted to the pool area without his or her own key. The pool gates must remain locked at all times.
- * Keys are not to be duplicated. Replacements for lost keys may be obtained from the association secretary for a nominal fee.
- Association member's children 16 years or older may swim on their own. Adult supervision is required for younger children.
- Parents, present or not, shall be responsible for their children while they are using the pool facilities.
- ❖ Parents are responsible for familiarizing children with the pool rules. All guests, regardless of age, are to be accompanied by an adult association member (18 years or older) while in the pool area.
- Large groups of guests are not usually allowed. Please send requests to use the pool for special purposes such as parties to the association board for prior approval.
- ❖ No alcoholic beverages allowed in pool area or parking lot at any time and no person under the influence of alcohol or drugs may use the pool.
- For your safety, always swim with a buddy who can assist you.
- ❖ No running, dunking, or "horseplay" is allowed around the pool.
- Diving from the pool edge is prohibited.
- Use balls, spaghetti tubes, inner tubes, water wings, and water toys with courtesy. Please remove them from the pool and store them when you leave.
- All glass items are prohibited in and around the pool area.
- * Keep the pool area clean: deposit trash and cans in the containers provided.
- Shower before entering the pool.
- ❖ Babies must wear swimsuit diapers in the pool at all times.
- Vulgar language is prohibited.
- ❖ No animals or pets are allowed in the pool area.
- Persons with diarrhea illness or nausea should not enter the pool. Persons with skin, eye, ear or respiratory infections should not enter the pool.
- Persons with open wounds or lesions should not enter the pool.
