

GETTING THERE

Travelling to the Macarthur region couldn't be easier. The region is located less than an hour from Sydney CBD and airport, 50 minutes from Wollongong and less than 40 minutes from the Southern Highlands. Travelling to or from Canberra and the Blue Mountains are also an easy drive.

A direct rail service runs between Campbelltown and Sydney CBD and Airport, the trip takes just 40 minutes each way.

HISTORY




John Street, Camden c. 1890s

The Macarthur region has a rich and complex history, starting with Indigenous groups who lived in the area, the Dharawal, Dharug and Gundangurra people. This indigenous heritage is reflected in the naming of some of our natural spaces, including the Dharawal National Park in Wedderburn and Gundangurra Reserve in Mount Annan.

Shortly after the European settlement of Sydney, a number of cattle strayed from their herdsman and made their way south to the fertile pastures, and as a result the area was known for a time as the 'Cowpastures'.

The Macarthur region is now named for renowned pioneers John and Elizabeth Macarthur. John Macarthur was granted 5,000 acres in the Cowpastures in 1805 to develop the Australian wool industry. Macarthur named the estate 'Camden Park' and since the earliest days Camden Park has been central to Australia's history and agricultural heritage, with wheat farming and dairying being established in the region, as well as Australia's first commercial vineyard.

Belgenny Farm

The home farm of John and Elizabeth Macarthur dates back to 1805. This wonderful picturesque setting includes Belgenny Cottage built in 1820 and the oldest surviving collection of farm buildings in Australia. Camden Town Farm

Camden Town Farm, originally a 52 hectare dairy farm, was bequeathed to the local community by the late Llewella Davies. It is a unique green space on the flood plain surrounding Camden. The Town Farm is a working farm with grazing dairy and beef cattle on site and lucerne pastures. The farm uses sustainable farming practices. A community garden also operates within the farm. The original heritage listed barn and surrounding buildings are very popular with artists and photographers alike, particularly for wedding and promotional photos. Belgenny Farm

The farm of John and Elizabeth Macarthur dates back to 1805 and includes Belgenny Cottage built in 1820. Belgenny Farm is the oldest collection of farm buildings in Australia.

Camden Park House

Open the second last weekend in September.

The building and design was begun in 1832 and completed in 1835, a year after John Macarthur's death. Architect, John Verge, designed the mansion in Palladian style with a central two-storey block with one-storey wings and extensions at each side. Camden Park House, which has become one of the great mansions of Australia, is still occupied by the Macarthur family and is thought to be one of the oldest residences in the country still occupied by descendants. The family burial ground is located nearby and is the last resting place of John Macarthur and his direct descendants.

Cobbtby Village

Governor Macquarie named it Cobbedee, and when Gregory Blaxland was granted land here in 1812, he called it Cutbady Farm. The village of Cobbtby, nestled on the Nepean River, attracts much interest because of the lush country views and beautifully kept historic buildings. Stroll through the markets held on the first Saturday of the month (excluding January and February).

John Oxley Cottage

Originally part of the grant made by Governor Lachlan Macquarie to John Oxley in 1815 and 1816. There is no record of its original builder, but it is a typical 'workman's cottage' thought to have been built in the 1890s and now houses Camden Visitor Information Centre.

Gledwood Homestead

Open for group tours and special events. Bookings essential.

Originally named 'Buckingham', the property now 'Gledwood' was a grant of 400 acres made to Gabriel Louis Marie Huon de Kerillian in 1810. De Kerillian was a French nobleman who fled the Revolution and joined the NSW Corps as Gabriel Lewis, arriving on the "Surprise" in 1794. He was at one time a tutor to John Macarthur's sons. De Kerillian was issued with eight convicts who constructed a residence on the property. This first building later became the kitchen for the homestead. The second building was a coach house and the third a cottage for the convicts in which they were chained at night. These buildings still stand and are distinguished from later buildings because they are made from local sandstone. In 1816, the property was sold to James Chisholm for £250.

Glenalvon and the Campbelltown and Airds Historical Society

Open the first Monday, and second and fourth Saturday of every month (except Easter) - February to mid December, 10am - 1pm. Also open by appointment for groups and schools.

Built in 1840 by Michael Byrne, this fine Colonial Georgian townhouse is home to the Campbelltown and Airds Historical Society. Wander through this beautiful historic property and visit the custom built Alex Goodeell Rural Exhibition Centre, showcasing the agricultural heritage in the area. The entire complex, including the coach house and stables, sits in a peaceful heritage garden. The Historical Society aims to collect and preserve items and information relevant to the history of the Campbelltown district and to present items in an interesting and educational manner. The society has published a large number of books and produce three journals a year, as well as a regular newsletter.

Wivenhoe House

Open first Sunday of the month (Feb to Nov), 11am - 3pm.

Built by Charles Cowper on 800 acres granted to his father Rev William Cowper in 1812.

It was named after his wife Eliza Sutton's home in England. The house was completed in 1838 and its design has been attributed to colonial architect, John Verge. Over the years, stables, an enclosed courtyard, coach house and servants' quarters were added.

CAMP BELL TOWN ARTS CENTRE

The Campbelltown Arts Centre is a state-of-the-art facility delivering a broad range of contemporary cultural programs in both the visual and performing arts. The centre features a range of exhibitions and artists collaborations each year and is an ideal venue for exploring the culture of the Macarthur region or holding a private function. The centre hosts an annual program of workshops, visual arts, music , dance, live art and emergent practices.

THE JAPANESE GARDEN AND TEAHOUSE

The Japanese Garden has a traditional waterfall, koi pond, timber bridge, stonework paths and flourishing plants. The teahouse was a Bicentennial gift from Koshigaya, Campbelltown's sister city in Japan. Wander around the garden and relax to the tranquil sounds of the waterfall. The garden is a popular location for weddings, functions and photographs.

The Japanese Garden and Teahouse symbolises the beliefs and religion of both Shinto (the indigenous religion of Japan) and Zen Buddhism. Shinto beliefs are concerned with aspects of the universe and natural objects are the abode of spirits, resulting in an implanted reverence in Japanese people for nature. Zen Buddhism inspired the creation of gardens for contemplative or meditative practices, or to illustrate particular Zen concepts.





Dharawal National Park



THE GEORGES RIVER

FRERE'S CROSSING

Georges River Rd, Kentlyn

A significant heritage site containing the remnants of an old wooden bridge that formed part of a connection between Campbelltown to Newcastle up to 1917. The crossing was named after George Pierre Frere, who owned a property at Eckersley. By 1913, all residents had been moved out of the area to make way for the military reserve. It is one of the most scenic sites along the Georges River in the Campbelltown area. Take a walk and enjoy the serene environment. There are no formal picnic facilities located at Frere's Crossing.

Frere's Crossing Walking Trail

Distance: 2km return walk along an established fire trail.

Grade: Medium, includes hills. Trail surface is loose and rocky in places.

Sleep sections.

Suitable for: Bushwalking and experienced mountain bike riding.

INGLEBURN RESERVE

Picnic Grove, Ingleburn

A bushland reserve located in Ingleburn. Situated on the Georges River, the reserve contains the historic Ingleburn Weir, which was constructed in the late 1930s to provide a swimming area for the local community.

The weir has a high heritage significance due to its sandstone structure and form. Works have been undertaken to enhance fish passage in the river system and maintain the heritage value of the weir. The vegetation community at Ingleburn Reserve is classified as the endangered ecological community, Shale Sandstone Transition Forest. The reserve is home to a number of endangered plant species, as well as a range of native birds, some marsupials, other small mammals and reptiles. Picnic tables and toilet facilities are located at the reserve.

Ingleburn Reserve Walking Trail

Distance: 400m return walk takes visitors down to the weir.

Grade: Medium. Sandstone steps. Surface is loose and rocky in places.

Suitable for: Bushwalking and picnics.

KEITH LONGHURST RESERVE

Georges River Rd, Kentlyn

The Keith Longhurst Reserve is a 76 hectares bushland reserve with significant scenic and cultural values. The reserve, formerly known as The Basin Reserve, includes a number of walks including The Basin Walking Track and the Old Ford Road Walking Track, which is an historic road built in the 1880s to cross the Georges River. The Dharawal people originally inhabited the area, and there are many sites of cultural significance. There are no formal picnic facilities located at Keith Longhurst Reserve.

The Basin Walking Track

Distance: 2km return walk.

Grade: Medium. The end of the track is quite steep and is only recommended for people of moderate fitness.

Suitable for: Bushwalking.

The Old Ford Road Walking Track

Distance: 2.6km return walk

Grade: Easy. An established, sloping track, suitable for a wide variety of fitness levels.

Suitable for: Bushwalking and mountain biking.

SIMMO'S BEACH RESERVE

Fifth Ave, Macquarie Fields

Simmo's Beach is located on the Georges River. Its easy access, picnic system and beach area make it a popular site for local residents. The reserve, which was officially opened in 1986, is named after Simmonds, a past resident, who mined sand adjacent to the Georges River for a number of years. The reserve's extensive areas of bushland, proximity to the Georges River and connectivity with the Georges River Regional Open Space, means it provides a range of recreational opportunities. Toilets, picnic tables and BBQ facilities available.

Simmo's Beach Walking Trail

Distance: Various tracks ranging from 500m to 1.5km return walks.

Grade: The tracks range from easy (paved, mostly flat) through to hard (narrow, sloping, unsealed).


Suitable for: Bushwalking and picnics.



HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL IMPORTANCE

The Georges River was an important focal point for Aboriginal life and culture in the southern Sydney region, offering both food, transport and dreamtime links. Several major language groups existed along the river: Eora to the east, Dharug to the west, north and north-east, Dharawal to the south and Gundangarra in the far south-west. The early 1800s saw European settlers migrating to the areas along the Georges River. Much of the catchment was cleared for farmlands and housing, however the banks stayed relatively untamed due to their rugged slopes. Development within the catchment has flourished since WWII. Today, the Georges River and surrounds are a highly significant landscape feature of the Sydney region and the Campbelltown environment. It is home to much of the biodiversity that can be found in the region, including an active koala colony, and provides immense scenic value to the area.

The corridor also offers a number of recreational opportunities. This section outlines some of these recreational opportunities and where they can be undertaken.



DHARAWAL NATIONAL PARK

Campbelltown is home to Macarthur's very own national park - the Dharawal National Park. There are numerous walking tracks, both sealed and unsealed through the park, as well as a 30km cycle trail suitable for mountain biking.

Dharawal was proclaimed a national park in 2012. Seventy years of restricted public access has kept the area largely undisturbed, where pristine surroundings await you on your visit. Waterfalls, extensive upland swamps, steep-sided sandstone gorges, swimming holes and rock shelters are just some of the many fascinating landscape features you can explore.

Dharawal National Park is the perfect antidote to city living. At 6,500ha, the park supports a huge range of birds and animals, superb plant life and features numerous tracks to walk or ride and scenic spots to relax.

'Dharawal' refers to the language group of the local Indigenous people who have continued their relationship with the area for more than 15,000 years. Their long occupation of the area is evidenced by many Indigenous sites, making the reserve among the richest in Indigenous heritage in the Sydney region.



WALK DHARAWAL NATIONAL PARK

O'HARES CREEK WALKING TRACK AND LOOKOUT – WEDDERBURN

For some of the best views over the gorge, make tracks to the O'Hares Creek Lookout. To access the lookout, follow the O'Hares Creek Walking Track, a flat and easy, family friendly walk on a sealed path. The views from the lookout are spectacular, with scenic gorge views into O'Hares Creek and picturesque rockpools far below.

Distance: 2.8km return.

Grade: Easy. Flat, sealed surface.

JINGGA WALKING TRACK – WEDDERBURN

Jingga means 'nice and sweet' in reference to water, from the Dharawal language group. Follow the Victoria Road Fire Management Trail in an easterly direction for approximately 500m, then take the track on your right. Follow the Jingga Track and it will lead you to a spectacular waterhole along O'Hares Creek.

Distance: 2.8km return.

Grade: Hard, includes some steep hills and loose surfaces.

WALKING TRAIL – 101 MANAGEMENT TRAIL – WEDDERBURN

The 101 Management Trail will take walkers to one of the most scenic locations within the Dharawal National Park - Minerva Pool. Minerva Pool is a large wide pool with a rock island in the middle, with the pool fed by a small waterfall. The walking trail will take you to a viewing platform or you can follow the fork in the trail and head down to the water.

Distance: 2.4km return.

Grade: Medium, includes some steep sections and loose surfaces.

100 CYCLE TRAIL – APPIN

If you're looking to take your mountain bike out for a long ride, the 10B cycling trail offers the perfect day out. The trail starts from the Appin Road entrance of Dharawal National Park and follows an unsealed road through open forest and woodlands along a sandstone ridge. This is a great bike ride for small groups and families with older children. The last three kilometres present more of a challenge, when the trail descends into Stokes Creek Gorge, leading to a good slog back up to the park's northern entrance at Wedderburn.

Distance: 30km return ride.

Grade: Medium, unsealed surface.

Monthly guided walking tours of the beautiful Dharawal National Park are a popular way for visitors to discover more about the destination. The tours, which are held on the second Saturday of every month, are guided by a local Aboriginal Discovery Ranger and provide a fresh look at the landscape from a Koori perspective. 

PLANNING YOUR TRIP

When accessing bushland areas, care should always be taken. Please consider the following guidelines in planning your trip:

- Let someone know where you are going and when you should return by. If you do not return by the designated time, this person can alert the appropriate authorities to get you assistance.
- When in bushland areas, you should dress suitably, such as enclosed shoes, dress for the weather and wear appropriate sun protection (hat, sunglasses and sunscreen).
- You should always take water with you, as you cannot guarantee that there will be suitable drinking water sources in bushland areas.
- Please take your rubbish with you or place it in the bins provided.
- The Georges River may not be suitable for swimming, particularly after heavy rain. Entry into the water may result in illness or infection during this period. People swimming do so at their own risk.
- All visitors are to read and follow the site specific signage displayed at each reserve to keep yourself, other visitors and the environment safe.
- If travelling by car, make sure that your vehicle is locked and that you do not leave any valuables in your car.
- All fauna, flora and rock formations are protected.
- Keep to the signposted management trails and walking tracks.
- Wildfires can destroy lives and property, so be careful. Observe all fire bans.
- Any camping must be in designated camping locations.





A must see attraction is The Australian Botanic Garden Mount Annan. Set on more than 400 hectares of parkland, the garden features BBQ and picnic facilities, themed gardens, a restaurant, plant nursery, gift shop, walking tracks, interactive sculptures, children's playground, mountain biking trail and guided tours. So much variety all in one place.

NATURAL AREAS

The botanic garden has an interesting mosaic of natural areas that have their own intrinsic value. These woodland and native grassland areas contribute to the landscape character and visitor experience of the garden. These areas of remnant native vegetation are becoming increasingly rare in western Sydney as urban development continues, and the garden is now important for species' conservation and fauna habitat.

WILDLIFE

The Australian Botanic Garden Mount Annan has become an increasingly valuable 'green space' in a fast growing urban area. The size of the site, and interesting variety of landscapes, have made it an important fauna refuge. More than 160 bird species have been seen in the garden, and visitors can take advantage of the lakes, woodlands and grasslands to see this wide range of bird life. Native mammals such as the Wallaroo and Swamp Wallaby are commonly seen in their natural woodland and grassland habitats.

MOUNTAIN BIKE TRAIL

You can enjoy Aussie plants and wonderful views by cycling off the beaten track at the Australian Botanic Garden Mount Annan. There are feature gardens, lakes, picnic areas and toilet facilities scattered throughout. For the experienced road cyclist, the garden can be reached by bicycle, if you travel by train to Campbelltown Station. The Mountain Bike Trail is an international standard, purpose-built mountain bike trail that has been constructed within the garden. The trail caters for competent, intermediate and advanced levels of mountain bike enthusiasts.

MACARTHUR CENTRE FOR SUSTAINABLE LIVING

Adjacent to the Australian Botanic Garden, the Macarthur Centre for Sustainable Living is a community driven organisation with the aim of promoting sustainable homes and gardens. The Centre runs frequent workshops and has functioning displays on sustainable household practices.

THEMED GARDEN AREAS

The Australian Botanic Garden Mount Annan is Australia's largest botanic garden with more than 2,000 species of native plants. Mount Annan is the native plant garden of the Royal Botanic Gardens and Domain Trust, which also manages the Royal Botanic Gardens Sydney and the Blue Mountains Botanic Garden, Mount Tomah.

The garden covers 416 hectares and features themed gardens with BBQ and picnic facilities, a cafe, walking tracks, a plant nursery and gift shop, as well as interactive sculptures such as the Sundial of Human Involvement, the Federation Flower Maze and Jamie Durie's Room with a View. The garden is also home to the internationally significant research facility, The Australian Plantbank.

On the Wollemi Walk of Discovery, visitors can explore the Wollemi Pine collection grown at the garden since the "living fossil" was discovered in 1994. This world-first is home to exact genetic replicas of the ancient trees found in the secret gorge in Wollemi National Park. It is an important part of the Conservation Management Plan to conserve these amazingly rare and endangered trees.
