Start / Finish / Registration

Parking, registration, and start line is located at the Brandon Burlsworth Youth Center, 202 South Spring, Harrison, AR. Rest rooms and showers will be available. Two feed zones with neutral water hand-ups will be located at (approx.) miles 32 & 42. Each category will also have a wheel/follow truck (wheels in - wheels out).

Race finish is the same location, Burlsworth Youth Center. where race results will be posted, and a post-race meal can be enjoyed.

Race Course Details

58 miles 5,500 ft elevation gain 15% grades

The TDH road race is held on a course affectionately known as the Jasper Disaster. There are 3 major climbs (Pruitt, Mt. Sherman, and Ponca), 2 thrilling descents, and miles of beautiful Ozark scenery.

Race Guidelines

- Tour de Hills is a USAC sanctioned road race, and all USAC rules are in effect.
- Event will be held rain or shine.
- Valid and current USAC license must be presented at registration.
- Non-licensed Men's Category 5 and Women's Category 4 (riders that have never held a higher racing classification license) may purchase a \$15 one-day license.
- Annual licenses will be available for purchase.
- Promoter reserves the right to adjust start times, mileage, or cancel/combine events for the safety of the riders.
- Unattached riders will be charged a \$5 unattached rider fee on race day with the exception of Cat 5 Men, Cat 4 Women, and Juniors.

Tour Rides

In addition to the 58 mile competitive road race, Tour de Hills also offers the same route as a tour for cyclists wanting a more recreational, leisurely, or family ride. The course is marked with signs that riders can easily follow and includes rest stops stocked with water, fruit, and snacks. The tour ride will start at approximately 10:40 am.
