



The Villages of Creekside Refuse / Recycling Guide

Thank you for choosing Waste In Time Disposal for your community refuse and recycling needs. Below are a few bullets about our contracted services.

REFUSE

- Monday Morning pick up weekly – up to 5, 32 gallon trash bags per residence. If additional bags are needed on a regular basis, you may purchase additional services to increase your plan at a discounted rate. If you have additional bags we also sell “Extra Bag” tags for \$2.00 per tag in sheets of 10.
- Place trash out Sunday Evenings. We will be collecting at 6am most Monday mornings, if you miss the pick up, you will need to wait until the following week.
- NO YARD WASTE IS INCLUDED – If you have a need for yard waste collection, we sell “YARD WASTE TAGS” for \$2.00 per tag in sheets of 10 and all yard waste must be placed OUTSIDE of your trash bin on the ground for us to clearly see the purchased tags. If no tag is on the bag, then those bags will not be picked up.
- Large Bulky items (Mattress, Tables, couches etc) require a call in advance and may have an additional fee. These items will not be picked up unless scheduled in advance.
- Holidays / Inclement Weather – If a Holiday or inclement weather falls on a Monday that we are NOT collecting then your collection will be the following day. Please watch our website for scheduled Holidays and updates due to inclement weather delays.

RECYCLE

Recycling will be picked up WEEKLY on your scheduled pick up day. Recycle is unlimited, but only the items recognized by Lebanon County Recycle program will be collected.

What Can Be Recycled?
Only the following materials can be recycled. Think of them as the “Big 4”. Everything else should be placed in your trash. If you aren’t sure, remember this phrase: “When in doubt, throw it out!” LCSWMA will transform discarded waste into renewable energy.
CORRUGATED CARDBOARD:
This includes any size material consisting of a fluted corrugated sheet,

like shipping boxes, packing boxes, CLEAN pizza boxes (no grease or food remnants), etc. Flatten all boxes and remove packaging including Styrofoam, peanuts, bubble wrap and plastic liners. Do NOT put paperboard (cereal boxes, shoe boxes), newsprint or junk mail in the bin.

PLASTIC BOTTLES AND JUGS:

This includes plastic bottles, jars, jugs and anything else with a neck. Throw away the lids and rinse out any residue. All other plastic material is considered trash. Ignore the numbers, as they don't indicate if something is recyclable. Do NOT put plastic bags, toys, buckets, packaging, Styrofoam, hosing, furniture, or other plastic items in the bin.

METAL FOOD AND BEVERAGE CANS:

This includes all food and beverage cans made from aluminum or steel. Throw away the lids and rinse out any residue. Do NOT put metal hangers, cooking pots and pans or other scrap metal like foil and pie plates in the bin.

GLASS:

This includes clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars. Throw away the lids and rinse out any residue. Do NOT put light bulbs, dishes, glassware, window or automotive glass, vases or any other glass material in the bin.

NEWSPAPER: (Lebanon County Only)

We will take dry newspapers in your recycle bin for Lebanon County Customers only. No junk mail however.
