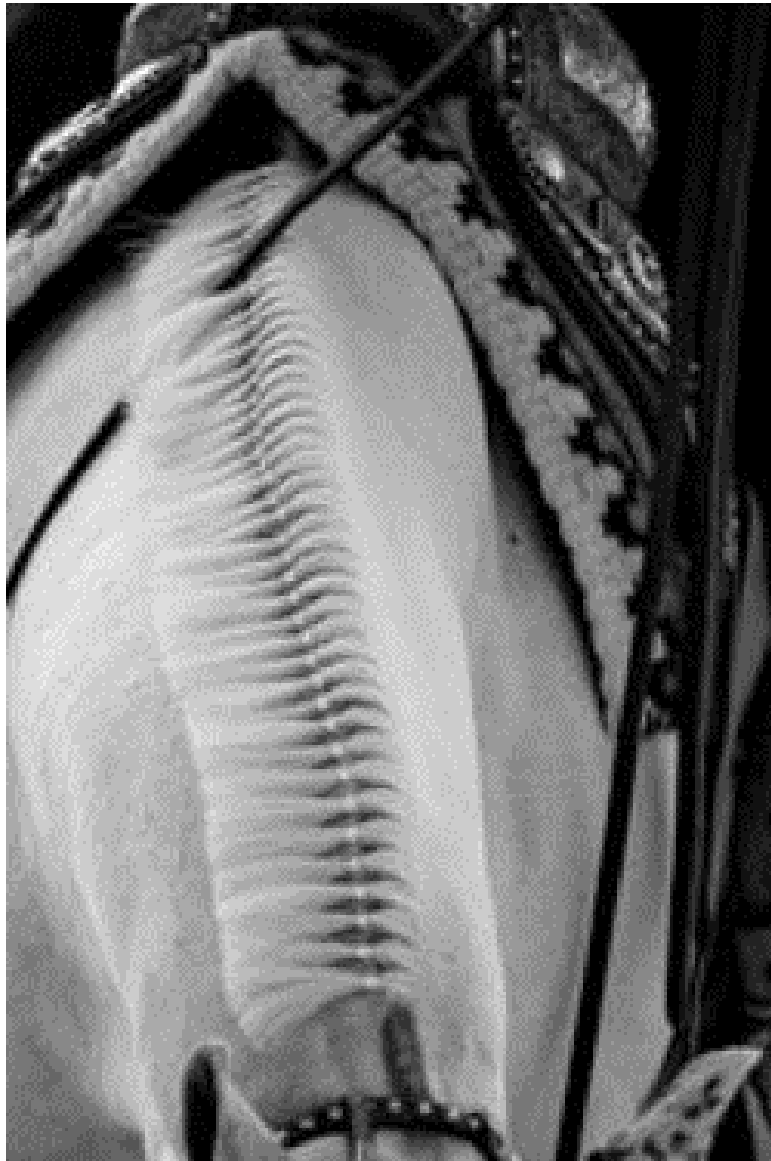

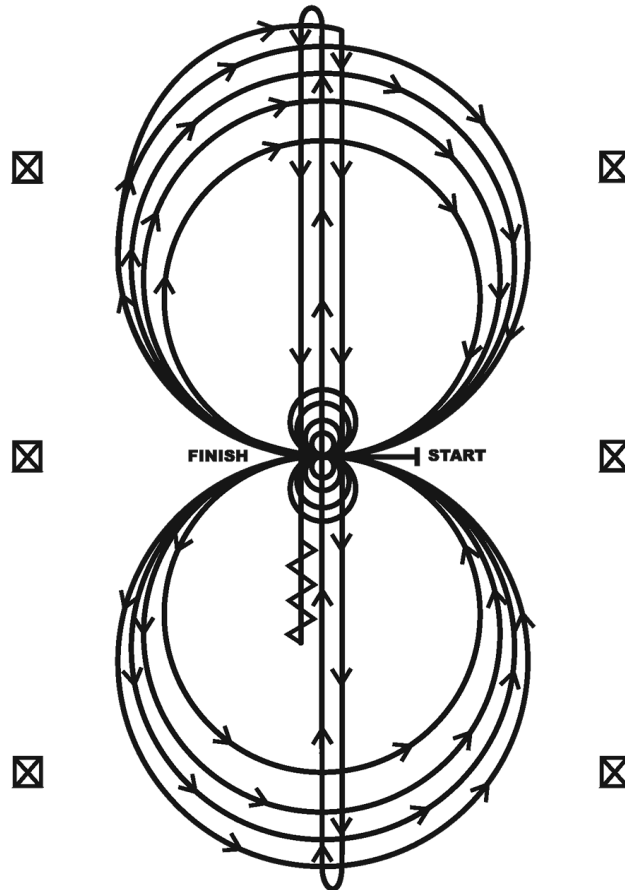

## Reining (Beginner & Amateur)

Show Date: 05-19-2024

Beginners may do simple or flying lead changes

### REINING PATTERN 4



Horses may walk or jog to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the right lead, run a large fast circle to the right, change leads at the center of the arena, run a large fast circle to the left, and change leads at the center of the arena. (Figure 8)
6. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
7. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
8. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

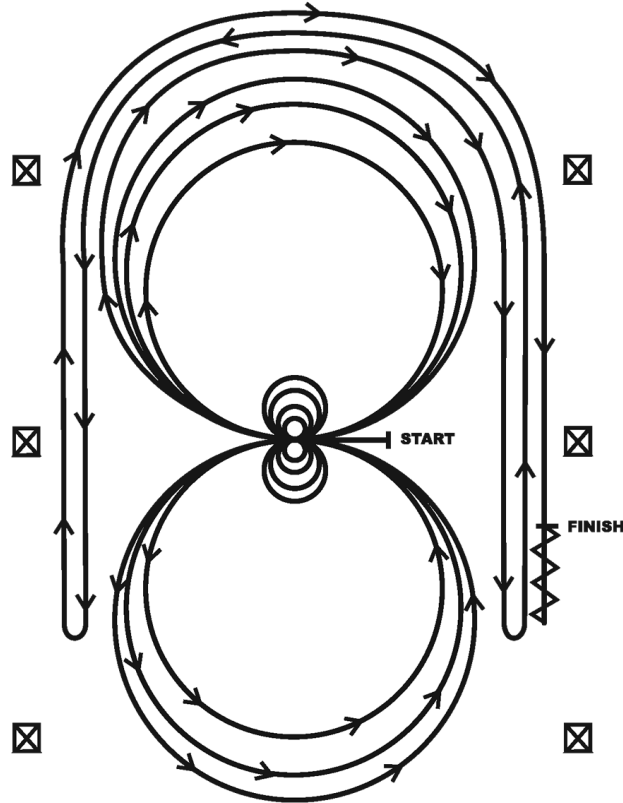

## Reining (Open)

### REINING PATTERN 8



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
4. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
5. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
6. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
7. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

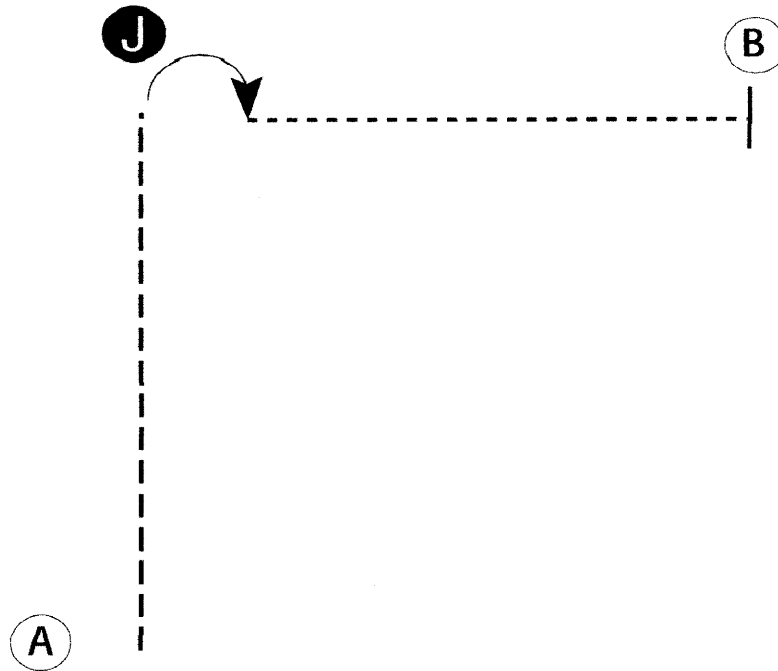

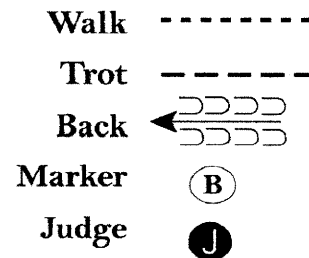

4. Walk away from judge to B.
5. Stop at B.
6. Follow the instructions of your ring steward.

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1. Jog A to B
2. At B Lope a circle on the right lead, continue the lope to C
4. At C stop and back 4 steps

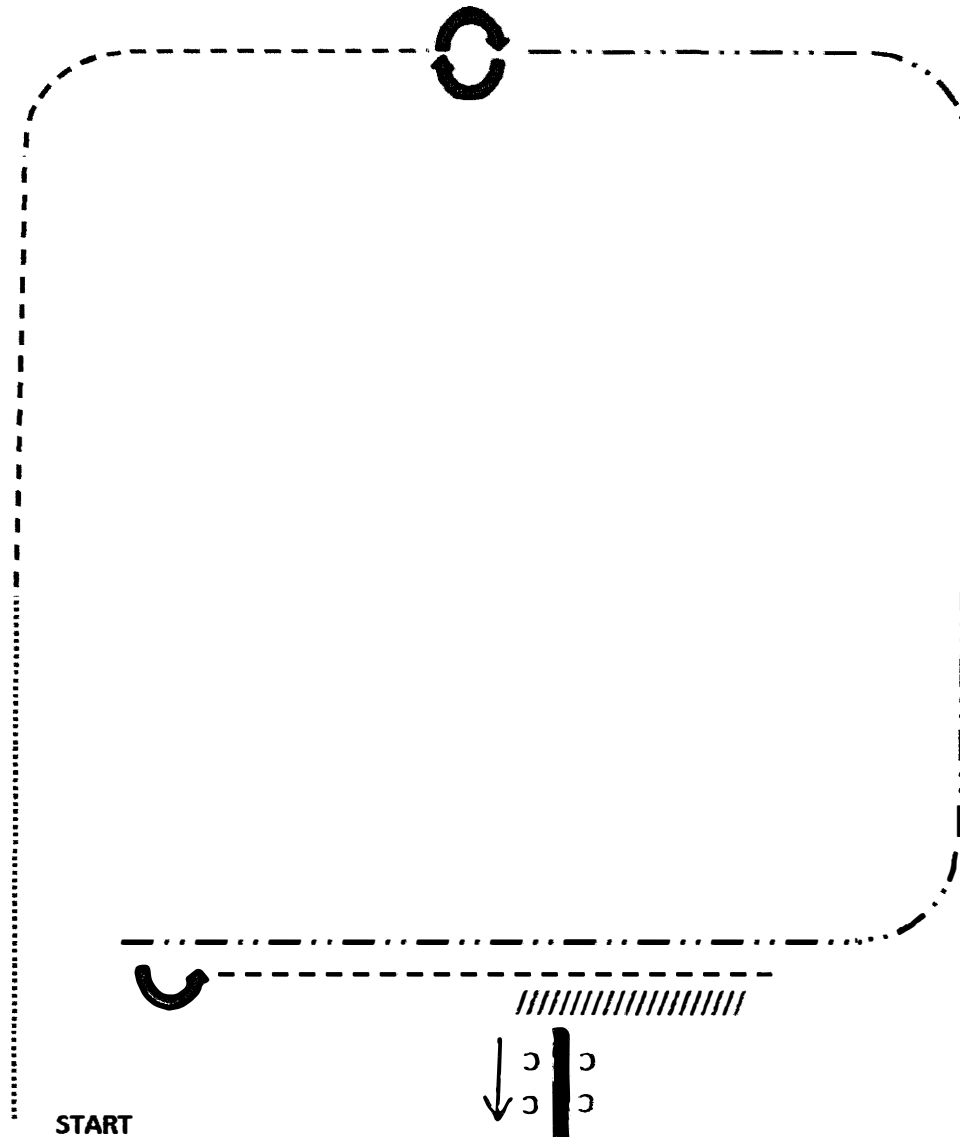

**USE ONLY 1/2 of Arena**

1. Walk
2. Trot
3. 360 Right
4. Extended Trot
5. Stop, 180 Left
6. Trot, past center
7. Stop & Back to center
8. Side Pass Rail Right

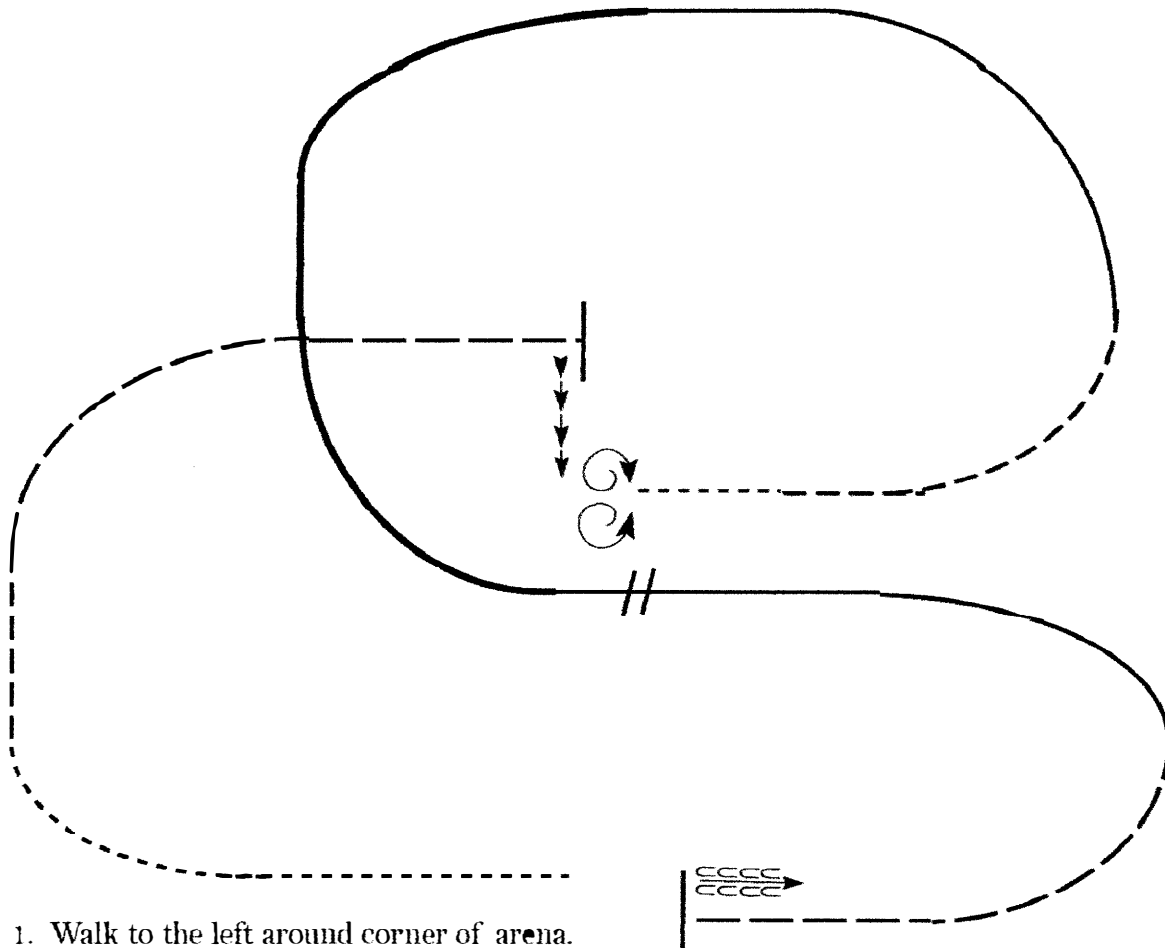

## Ranch Riding (Beginner & Open)

Show Date: 05-19-2024

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1. Walk to the left around corner of arena.
2. Trot
3. Extend alongside of the arena and around the corner to center.
4. Stop, side pass right
5. 360 degree turn each direction (either way 1st)
6. Walk.
7. Trot.
8. Lope left lead
9. Extend the lope
10. Change leads (simple or flying)
11. Collect to the lope
12. Extend trot
13. Stop and back

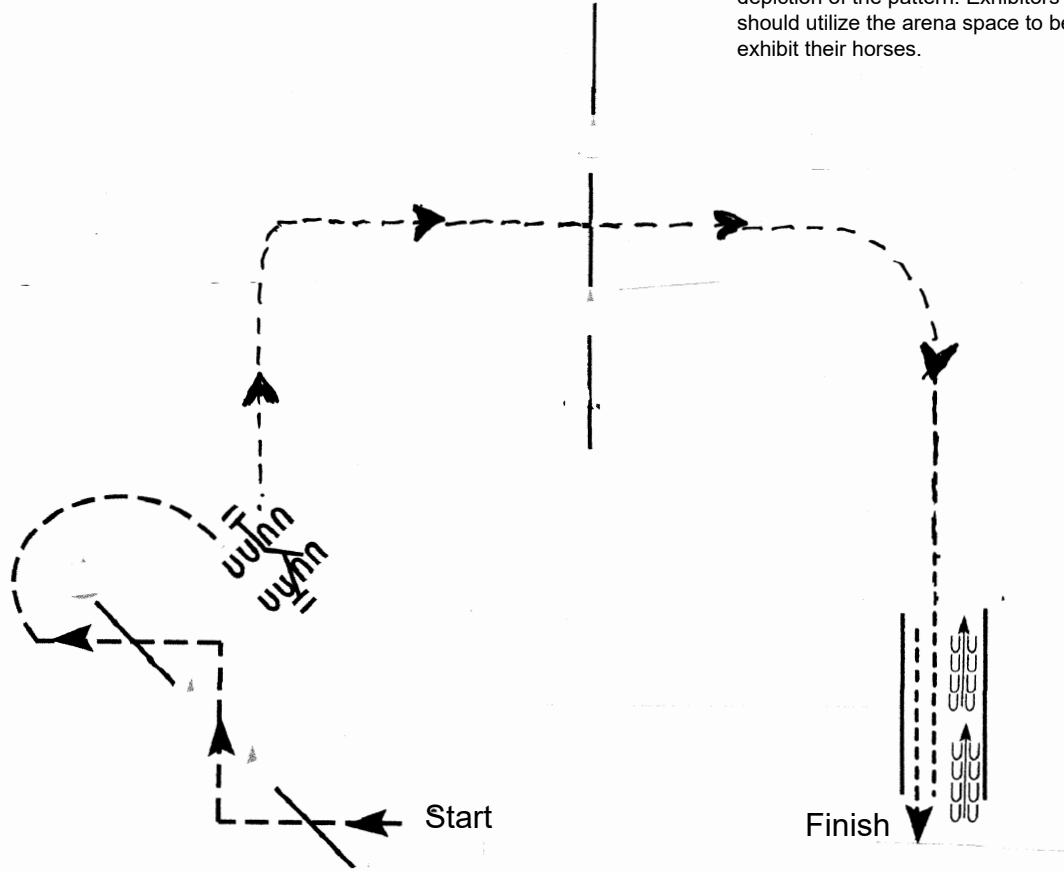

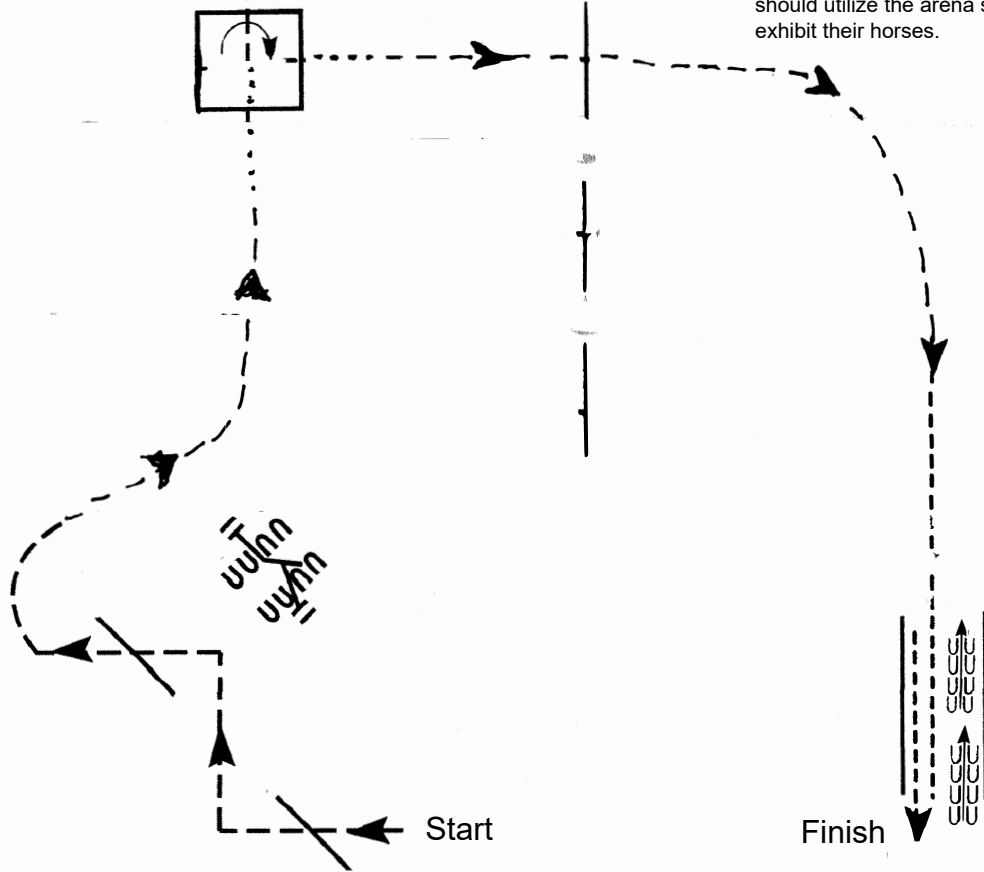

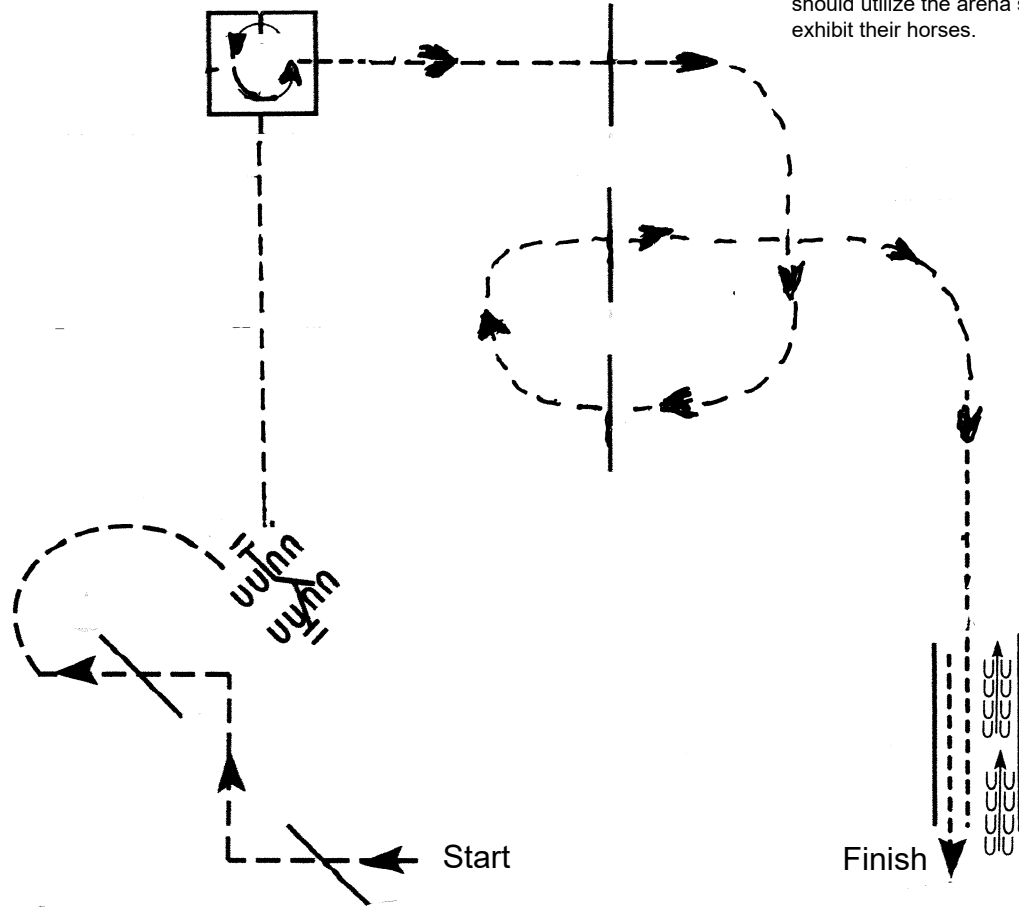

5. Jog over poles as shown; break to walk before chute.
6. Walk into chute to the end.
7. Back 1 horse length and walk out of chute to finish course.

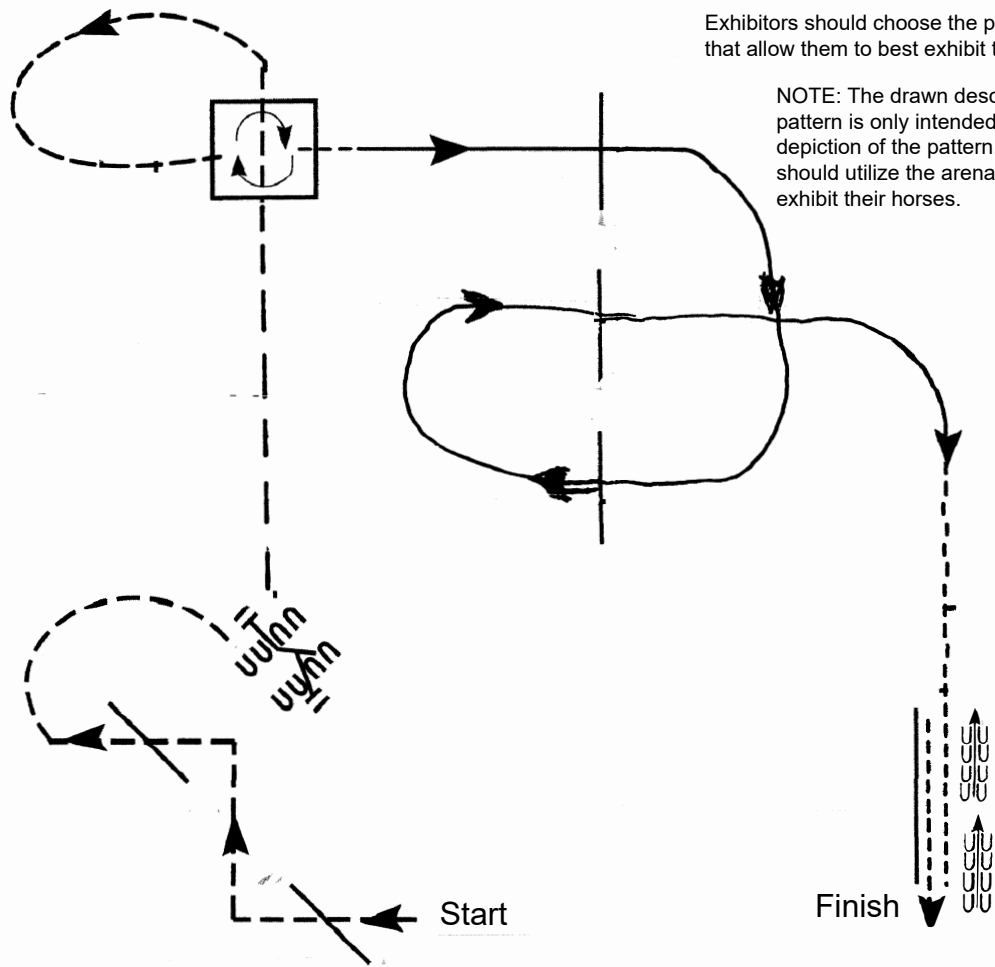

1. Jog over poles as shown to gate.
2. Work gate, left hand.
3. Extend jog to box; stop.
4. Walk into box; perform 360 to the left.
5. Walk out of box & pick up a jog; jog thru box.
6. Pick up lope and lope over poles as shown.
7. Break to walk before chute; walk into chute to the end.
8. Back 2 horse lengths and walk out of chute to complete course.

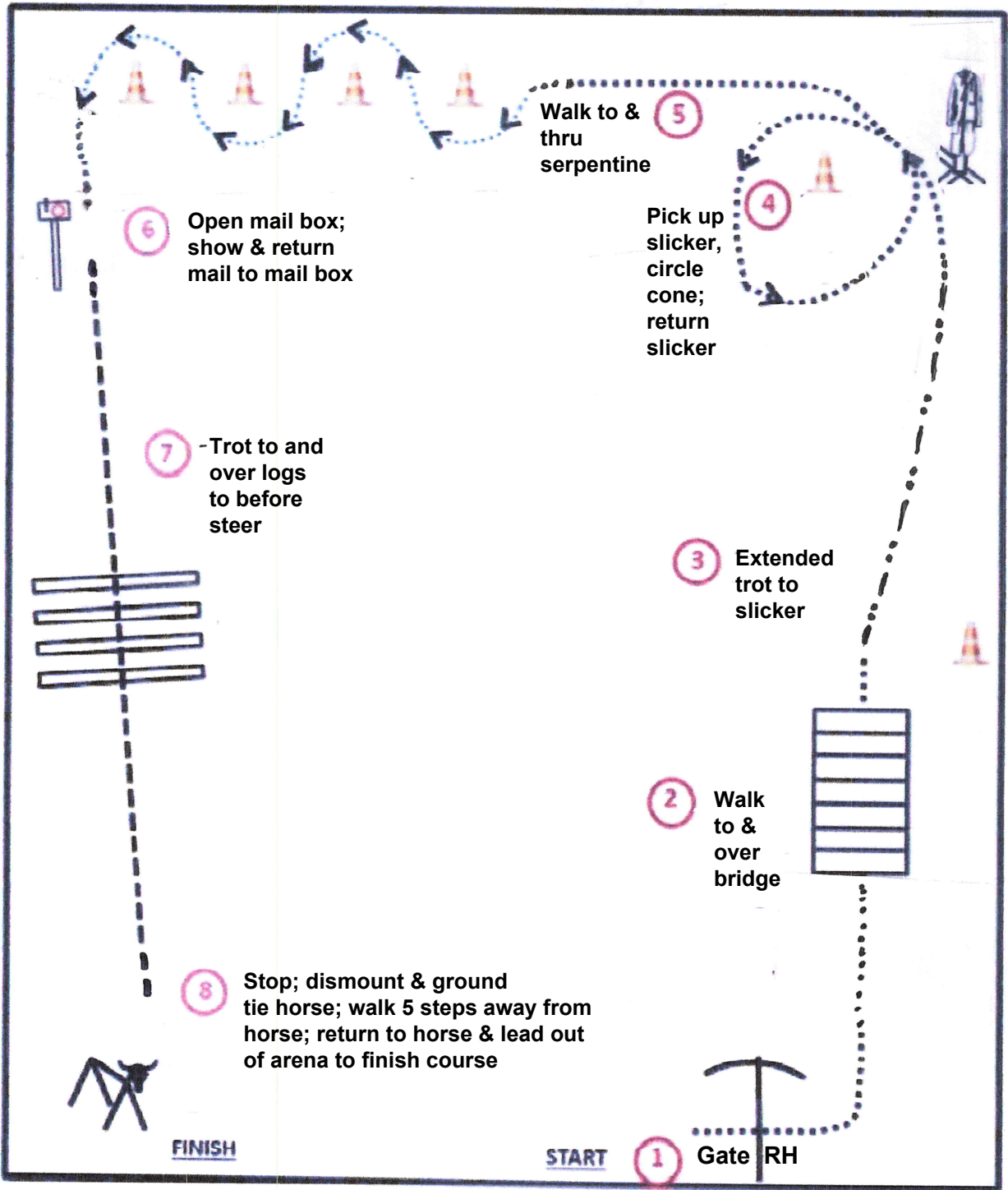

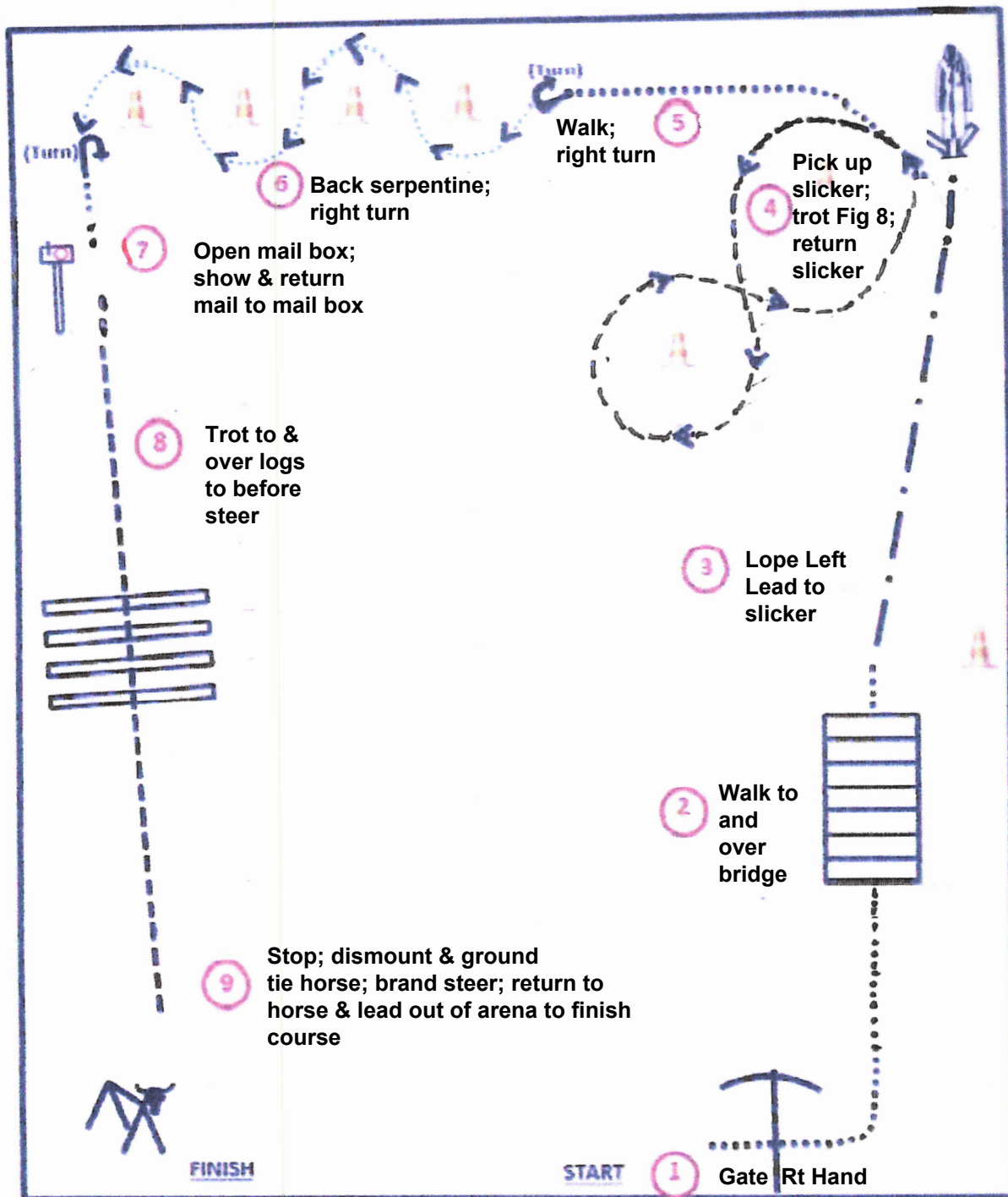
