Approximately 22500 Red Cross parcels on hand being held by Russians. General state of health good. Commander of Prisoners of War is Col HUBERT ZEMKE, Air Corps. Standfast orders being obeyed. Radio receivers operate. Good reception on commercial band, especially BBC broadcasts. Nearest airfield located 2 miles south of camp. Col ZEMKE requests air evacuation Above information received verbally from ex-PW Capt JOHN F BELL 0389828, HQ Ninth Air Force.
