



Horse Palace Riding Pass Rules:

The Horse Palace serves the active involved horse owner as well as first time and experienced riders, and has provided a central meeting place for many equine activities. The Spring Creek Association urges Horse Palace users to participate by telling us their ideas and individual needs. It is through payment for services that the Association can keep up the facilities and make improvements to our amenities.

- No. 1: If you are riding at the Horse Palace without a pass or current waiver on file you will be given a warning and asked to pay for that day.
- No. 2: If you are riding at the Horse Palace a second time without a pass or current waiver on file, we will send a letter informing you of this and you will not be allowed to ride for 60 days. If you ride within the 60-day time frame, it will be considered trespassing on SCA property and proper actions will be taken.
- No. 3: If you are riding at the Horse Palace a third time without a pass or current waiver of file, we will send a certified letter informing you that you are no longer allowed to ride at the Horse Palace. If you are riding after the certified letter is sent, it will be considered trespassing on SCA property and proper actions will be taken.

A few Reminders:

- You **MUST** have a signed waiver and current pass to ride
- Please make sure you are cleaning up after your animals
- No parking in fire lanes
- No Glass bottles, alcohol or smoking of any kind
- Please do not clean your trailer in parking lot
