Core Competencies for IL-TERT Deployments:

General

Maintain personal and agency readiness levels for deployment(s). (Training, documentation, equipment, and interagency relationships) <u>No Self-Deployments</u>

Mobilization

- 1. Obtain complete information from dispatch upon initial activation
- 2. Coordinate with Team Leader for mobilization.
- 3. Maintain your own travel, mileage, expenses and hours.

Arrival

- 1. Arrive at incident and check in (as a team if possible)
- 2. Obtain briefing and receive IAP
- 4. Determine requirements for communications (IAP/305)
- 5. Evaluate needs and order supplies
- 6. Organize and assemble team(s) and shifts
- 7. On shift-setup, Off shift- rest period.
- 8. Design communications unit to fulfill needs of incident
- 9. Install/setup communications equipment
- 10. Assign Communications Equipment
- 11. Coordinate frequencies, activities and resources with the Communications Leader (COML)
- 12. Establish ICC
- 13. Notify appropriate local, county, regional, state and federal agencies
- 14. Initiate and maintain accurate records of all communications
- 15. Perform operational tests of communications systems throughout the duration of the incident
- 16. Interact and coordinate with appropriate unit leaders and operations personnel
- 17. Forward all messages, updates and resource requests.
- 19. Maintain ICS Unit Log and Shift Log.
- 20. Prepare for Demobilization

Demobilization.

- 1. Turn in all required paperwork, logs, equipment and brief relief
- 2. Introduce new team members to IC staff
- 3. Travel safely to home agency maintaining logs and check in with Dispatch
- 4. After Action Report/Deployment Debriefing
