### **AGREEMENT:**

In order to be considered for the adoption of a rescue Chihuahua held by the New Zealand Chihuahua Rescue Trust ("The Trust"), you, as the ("the Adopter") hereby agree to the following:

- 1. In the event that you are no longer able to care for the dog at any time. The Trust is to be notified immediately and the dog returned into the care of the Trust.
  - **1.1** For the absence of any doubt, the dog cannot be advertised or rehomed privately, under any circumstances.
- 2. By applying to the Trust, the Adopter confirms they are able to provide an excellent environment for the dog to reside in and have the ability to pay Council registration as it falls due each year and provide any medical care required during the life of the dog, together with basic necessities and inside housing.
- 3. The Adopter is responsible for transferring the registration of the dog into their own district and name. The Adopter must (within the first month of receiving the dog) change any Council registration into their name. This is a fundamental term of adoption.
- **4.** The dog will be micro-chipped and added to the New Zealand Companion Animal Register. The Trust (or Managing Trustee of the Trust) will remain the primary contact on the microchip. This is a fundamental term of adoption. The Adopter can add themselves as a secondary contact but is not, under any circumstances, to remove the Trust's details from the microchip.
- 5. Dogs will be de-sexed prior to adoption. In the case that they have not been (ie. where a foster carer chooses to adopt and the dog is already with them) Any dogs that have been property of the Trust are not to be bred from. Proof of de-sexing supplied to the trust within the first month of adoption.
- **6.** The Trust provides all necessary medical care and confirms that it has disclosed to the Adopter, prior to adoption any medical issues known to the Trust. Vaccinations are the individual choice and responsibility of the Adopter.
- 7. The Trust does not offer "trials". The Adopter should be committed to the dog from the outset. In the event that the adoption does not work out, the dog always has a place with the Trust and needs to be returned to the care of the Trust, pursuant with clauses 1 and 1.1.
- **8.** In the event that the Adopter breaches any terms contained in this Agreement. The Trust reserves the right to immediately uplift the dog. The Trust reserves the right to uplift a dog should any concerns arise in relation to welfare.

#### 9. Application Process

**9.1** The Adopter is to return the application form to the email below, together with any required evidence from a landlord.

- 9.2 By submitting the form to The Trust for consideration, the Adopter confirms that all information supplied is true and correct to the best of their knowledge and belief; and that they have no pending charges or prior convictions related to animal cruelty.
- **9.3** The information on the forms will be retained by The Trust.
- **9.4** A home check and interview may be conducted with the chosen Adopter, at the Trust's discretion.
- **9.5** The Trust reserves the right to approve or decline any Adopter at any stage of the process. No reasoning will be entered into.
- 9.6 The welfare and best interests of the dog will be the primary consideration in determining whether an adoption should proceed. Other considerations include, but are not limited to: desire to achieve continuity of care, the particular needs of the dog, the presence of support from members of the household, extent of bond between carer and dog, ability to financially provide for the dog and potential for the dog to remain in that home for life.
- **9.7** The non-refundable adoption fee of \$400.00 is to be paid prior to confirmation of the adoption. This fee covers care of the dog to date (health, basics, de-sexing, vaccinations).
- **9.8** Applying to The Trust to become an Adopter does not create an obligation on The Trust to supply the Adopter with a dog.
- **9.9** The decision of The Trust is final.
