

RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE
BYLAW #10 - 78

A bylaw to provide for the entering into an agreement to provide road ambulance service.

The Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Resort Village of Tobin Lake, is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the council (or councils) of:
 1. Town of Nipawin
 2. Town of Carrot River
 3. Village of Choceland
 4. Village of Codette
 5. Village of Love
 6. Village of White Fox
 7. Village of Smeaton
 8. Village of Aylsham
 9. Rural Municipality of Moose Range #486
 10. Rural Municipality of Nipawin #487
 11. Rural Municipality of Torch River #488
 12. Rural Municipality of Connaught #457

the terms of which are attached hereto and form part of this bylaw, for the purpose of establishing a municipal road ambulance board to provide road ambulance service

- (a) throughout the Resort Village of Tobin Lake.
2. The Municipal Road Ambulance Board, established under the provisions of paragraph one (1), is hereby authorized to operate a road ambulance service.
3. The Municipal Road Ambulance Board is hereby empowered to enter into an agreement with (i) a Union Hospital, an individual or a duly incorporated organization to provide road ambulance services, or (ii) to purchase and operate the required equipment for the purpose of providing road ambulance services.
4. The Village shall pay an operating grant to the Board and such grant shall be determined each year.
