

BYLAW NO. 3/92


A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, TO
REGULATE LIVESTOCK WITHIN THE VILLAGE.


The Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan enact as follows:

1. In this bylaw "livestock" shall mean cattle, horses, sheep, goats, swine, live poultry, bees, rabbits, fur bearing animals, elk and skunk.
2. No person shall harbour and/or keep any livestock at any time within the boundaries of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake.
3. Any person found guilty of any infraction of the provision of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village being Bylaw No. 2, 1974.
4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.
