


BYLAW NO. 2/98


A Bylaw to Provide a Uniform System for Numbering of Cabins and Buildings in the Resort Village of Tobin Lake

The Council of the Resort Village of Tobin Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enact as follows:


1. That a Uniform System of Numbering Cabins and other Buildings as shown by the numbering map shall be endorsed by the Resort Village of Tobin Lake.
2. That should numbers now exist on any cabins and other building, not conforming with the provisions of this Bylaw, be changed to conform to the system as provided by Bylaw No. 2/98.
3. A separate house number shall be assigned for each fifty (50) feet of a property, (more or less), to which the Village mapping has deemed to be considered the frontage.
4. Each cabin or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated. In the case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling or business, each separate front entrance of said home shall bear a separate number.
5. Numerals indicating the official number shall be posted in a manner to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
6. The Village Administrator or Clerk, shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this Bylaw.
7. Numerals may be obtained from the Village, for a fee of One Dollar (\$ 1.00) per numeral.
