


**RESORT VILLAGE OF TOBIN LAKE
BYLAW NO. 3/2006**


The Council of The Resort Village of Tobin Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

That the following bylaws are hereby repealed:


1. Bylaw 14-1979, a bylaw to provide for the licensing of occupants of trailers, mobile homes and portable shacks.
2. Bylaw 15-1979, a bylaw to provide for the licensing of operators of trailer parks, mobile home parks or camps.
3. Bylaw 3-1995, a bylaw to provide for the creation of a debt not payable within the current year.
4. Bylaw 3-1997, a bylaw to provide for the creation of a debt to meet current operating and short-term capital expenditures.
5. Bylaw 1-2005, a bylaw to extend the time required for the completion of the assessment roll.
