The July Board meeting minutes were approved unanimously

Treasurer's Report: Resh not present

Membership: Penny Broberg reported that we have 209 paid members and waiting on for the rest.

A suggestion from the floor to have Broberg or Resh look into allowing members to pay their annual dues electronically, more on that as it becomes available.

## **Old Business**

Merging of departments, Penny Broberg mention that she will be working with our Treasurer going forward. A question from the floor came asking if we could have an electronic version of our annual directory, this too will be researched and brought back to the board at a later date.

Buoys - Doc reported that his team is ready to handle take out. He had a new idea for handling the floats. He related a

he had with Joel Miller, about using a pontoon to pickup and put out being able to do the work in one pass through the lake, and storing same for the winter on said pontoon. The board liked the idea if it was safe and could be done. Doc said he and Joel will try it out, and if it works, Mr. Miller will donate the pontoon to MLIA. The discussion was tabled until after drawdown when we should have our answer.

Welcoming Committee - Graham is putting together a package to give out to new property owners, and new people moving to

the area. She questioned if we could have a electronic version of what she has created, Haak thought it could be researched. Tammy also requested the names of new people moving in near by to us.

Invasive Species - Gilkey reported that his minions have searched the reaches of our lake and to-date have found nothing out of the ordinary.

Road Cleanup - Not present

Little Moose River Picnic Shelter - Koehler reported that he and Dean Broberg, Cary McDonald, Jeff Williams, Scott Gilkey, Ted Eisenbacher, Gary Hostetler took two pontoons out to the site and cleaned up the brush, re-piled last years brush and trash into burning piles and will request the Forest Service to burn them this winter. A spot was selected and a concrete pad was dug in and poured. A return trip will be needed to pull the forms and install the Susan Erickson bench, and finish the cleanup.

Broberg moved to installing dock bumper pads on both picnic area docks, Koehler seconded it, passed. A question about installing an American flag and pole at the two picnic sites, this was tabled for the next meeting and Dean will look into the cost.

2 Axe Update - Koehler reminded the board that this is a ten to fifteen year timber harvesting program by the US Forest Service, and that he had spoken to his contact and was told that based on what has happened so far a revised plan will be forth coming by the end of this September.

Town of Round Lake Chairman's letter - Haak reviewed the letter, and there was some discussion as to the need for new ordinance passage to address past situations. Haak pointed out that MLIA is in agreement that something needs to be done.

Annual Meeting review - The members seemed pleased with our speaker and the topic, meeting flow seemed to go well. There was a discussion of next years speaker candidates .
