OLD BUSINESS

1. PIA:
 - a. Water rescues in PCF during recent storms. They have been staffing up when forecasted.
 - b. SPFD, some chimney fires but most impactful issues is up-tick in calls for mutual aid into Sac Metro/ Folsom for their Medic. Up to 5 times a day due to staffing issues and less medics in Metro as well as wall times.
 - c. RSV apartment fire at Slate Creek identified some additional issues with our EF Johnson radios and P25 system. Loss of transmissions due to garbling of digital playback. This has been partially corrected with a volume control reprogram. End user training is scheduled. Short discussion on direction of the RSV radio system.
2. SOGs
 - a. Commercial Structure Fire SOG distributed for comment and group to take back to their respective agencies / SME's. Looking to have agency comments back by next meeting for further discussion.
 - b. RTF SOG is at Chief for final approval
3. Training Cadres
 - a. Chief Fowler states that Chief Feeley is looking at dates for RT-130 and it will be in Folsom Lake State Park.
