

## MINUTES OF FLORIDA UTILITIES COORDINATING COMMITTEE

The meeting was called to order at 10:20 A. M. by the Chairman, H. V. Street. Minutes of the previous meeting were read by the secretary, and there being no corrections they were approved as read.

Mr. Faraon was asked to give a report of his committies' finding concerning the newer type construction of the telephone terminal boxes. Mr. Faraon read a number of letters which had been received by him from various different utility companies concerning their opinion of this type construction. There had been no definite decision made by the committee of what action the committee would recommend. There was a lengthy discussion concerning this subject and decision was finally made that the telephone company and the power company should come to a mutual agreement in the territory where this construction was being used.

Mr. A. B. Green, engineer of the Florida Railroad Commission, was asked to comment on the R. R. crossing specifications which were being revised at this time. Mr. Green passed out copies of the old rules, regulations and specifications, both Part One and Part Two. These copies were marked with such changes which seemed necessary in making this code more up to date, after going over these changes orally. Mr. Warth suggested that copies be sent to each member that they might study them and make any comments they wished. It was also suggested that there be a meeting called in Tallahassee, notify the members to be present and present such suggestions and comments as they wish, so that any corrections could be made prior to the printing of these new regulations.

The next meeting is to be held at Jacksonville, Florida, Seminole Hotel, May 22. Meeting was adjourned at 12:10 P. M., to have luncheon, which was provided by W. M. Bostwick, Florida Power and Light Company, Daytona Beach, Florida.
