Mr. Menendez, chairman of the sub-committee on the coordination of highway and utility construction presented a report on a meeting with representatives of the State Road Department. This meeting was held at Tampa, Florida on January 25, 1946 and Mr. Menendez tock occasion to point out that the highway people were very receptive to the committee's objectives and that a broad spirit of cooperation was exhibited throughout the rather lengthy session. Considerable discussion was obtained as to probable results of the reeting. It was the general feeling that executives of the highway department had always been appreciative of the utility company's problems but that their subordinates and the contractors of the department did not always share these views. Mr. Davis pointed out that possibly they were unfamiliar with the general feeling of the department and suggested that copies of the subcommittee's report be distributed to all division and project engineers. Mr. Titus ventured that possibly the committee had not

adopted the proper policy and recommended closer personal contact with the district engineers and the contractors. Following a discussion as to an approach along these lines, Mr. Linhart moved that copies of the sub-committee's report be included with the minutes of this meeting and that an effort be made to give them as wide a circulation as possible. The motion was seconded by Mr. Davis and passed unanimously.

In connection with a discussion as to attendance, it was noted that the REA people were not as active as the committee had hoped. It was reported that some changes had been made in the REA engineering organization and that Mr. C. Mallison and Mr. S. G. Tankersley had been appointed and would probably handle the engineering in the Florida Peninsular while Mr. Ralph Smith would continue to handle Georgia and the West Florida areas. The committee roster was corrected and revised to include these engineers and hope was expressed that they would see fit to meet with the committee whenever possible.

Orlando was selected for the May 10, 1946 meeting of the committee and in the absence of a representative, it was assumed that the Winter Pork Telephone Company, as in the past, would be hosts.
