The minutes of the previous meeting were read and accepted. Also, the notices of intent received since the previous meeting were read for the information of the group.

Mr. J. T. Bayer briefed the Committee on a Southeastern Conference meeting which was recently held in Tallahassee, concerning wood poles. He states that it would be a good idea if one representative from each Utility Company would attend these meetings in order to gain more knowledge on the use of wood poles.

Mr. Stanley Warth mentioned that a new National Electric Safety Code for new clearances was now in the making which we will hear on later.

Mr. Ben Darlington introduced Mr. Don Gould of the University of South Florida, who then took the Committee on a tour of the campus buildings, which was most interesting.

After completion of the tour which lasted 1½ hours, Dr. Sidney J. French, Dean of the College of Basic Studies and Director of Educational Research at the University, spoke to the group on the educational program of the University. Dr. French, a native of Superior, Wisconsin, received his BS Degree from the University of Chicago and his MS and Ph.D Degrees from the University of Wisconsin. Dr. French was associated for 22 years with Colgate University as Professor of Chemistry and Dean of the Faculty. He was Dean of the College at Rollins College, Winter Park, for 4 years, before his appointment at the University of South Florida. Dr. French is listed in Who's Who and other biographical directories and has published more than 60 papers in scientific and educational journals.

The Committee voted to accept an invitation through Mr. Ken Williams to hold its next quarterly meeting in Sarasota on May 12, 1961, with Mr. Red Davis, Florida Power and Light Company, as host.

Chairman Griffin then adjourned the meeting and the Committee enjoyed a delicious fried chicken dinner as guests of the General Telephone Company and Tampa Electric Company.
