FLORIDA UTILITIES COORDINATING COMMITTEE

Meeting of August 2, 1963

This meeting, held at the Robert Meyer Hotel in Jacksonville, Florida on August 2, 1963, was called to order by Mr. Ed O'Connor. Due to the length of the minutes of May 3, 1963, the reading of the minutes was omitted but they were distributed and approved.

The following sub-committee reports were given:

Report on processing requirements of State Road use permits. Chairman Ed O'Connor distributed copies of the committees proposal for processing use permits - they were read and discussed. Mr. Joe Bayer recommended that each utility group study the proposal and make written recommendations to Mr. O'Connor for further study and revision by the subcommittee. The sub-committee will then prepare a new report and re-submit at the November 8 meeting in Daytona Beach.

Southeastern Telephone Company

(B) An affidavit and resolution was circulated and discussed. This, if adopted by any and all companies, would waiver the corporate seal on permit forms 121 revised, and 621-1 and -2. The question arose as to whether an officer had to sign the permits or as stated on the affidavit "an officer, official or agent delegated by the company" could sign. Mr. Bryan Henry, of the legal section of the Road Department was contacted in regards to this and he stated that the road department could only accept the signature of a

designated officer. Also, the question was raised as to whether the waiver of the Corporate Seal through the use of the resolution and affidavit would apply to the Subordination of Encumbrance to Right-of-Way. This was also reviewed with Mr. Henry and he advised that it would not.

- (C) Correspondence was read relative to the voltage limitation being raised on highway right-of-way. Revision of the original proposal removed the voltage limitation but limited the facility to a four wire primary and three wire secondary with necessary street light facilities.
- (D) The article from the Standard Road Department Specifications manual requiring grounding of fences on interstate systems was read. Mr. Noa made a motion to present a resolution to the road department requesting the elimination of grounding the fences and to describe the purpose for doing so. This motion was seconded by Pete Reid. The recommendation is to be directed to Mr. Jay Brown.

Mr. Ernest Salley commented on the recently published directory of the utility consulting engineers that was prepared by the Road Department. He pointed out that due to the high costs in this type publication that limited copies were distributed and he and Mr. Joe Bayer would pursue further publication with the American Right-of-Way Association.

Secretary Malloy circulated the mailing list for all members of the utility committee and asked that representatives of each company and firm in attendance review this list and make additions or deletions for their firm.

The Secretary also asked for discussion on notice of intent summary that was previously prepared and distributed. It was pointed out that in the manner that notices of intent are received and the time of distribution at quarterly meetings, that most of the construction had been completed and was past history. Also some notices of intent letters were very vague to the point that they could not be listed in the summary. Each notice of intent letter should give the road and approximate location preferably between two towns and a probable construction date and not to attached sketch, which is not attached. Mr. Joe Bayer made a motion to have a sub-committee appointed to investigate the notice of intent letters. Sub-committee named was Ed O'Connor, Ralph Oswald and Bill Malloy.

Mr. Homer Wilson made a motion that the secretary write a letter to the Road Department Chairman in appreciation of the increased cooperation that the Road Department has extended to the Florida Utility Committee during the past year. Motion was seconded by Joe Bayer.

Mr. Salley distributed for review a Notice on Plant, Proposal Forms and Escrow Accounts.
