Following self-introductions by those present, the minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted as written.

Verne Brown, chairman of the Accommodations Guide sub-committee, reported that action is pending from the State Road Department on a revised guide. Ernest Salley stated that he did not feel a revision would be available until after the April meeting with the Bureau of Public Roads.

The Bureau of Public Roads policies on P.P.M. 30-4 and P.P.M. 30-4.1 were made available to the group. An announcement was made that the Bureau would have a meeting in Atlanta, Georgia on April 22, 23, and 24, 1969 at the Georgia State Road Department Building. The purpose of the meeting is to answer questions on their recently adopted policies. The first two days are restricted to highway personnel, but the last day will be open for all utilities who wish to attend. The Bureau has requested they be advised on those wishing to attend. Arrangements for hotel reservations, etc. will have to be made by each individual.

Considerable discussion was held on ASSHO's proposed Accommodation Policy. The National Ad Hoc committee of the American Right-of-Way Association is meeting with ASSHO officials to comment on their proposal. Verne Brown advised he had talked with Mr. Gartner, Deputy State Highway Engineer, and was told the state would not delay adopting their guide. Mr. Gartner stated that if ASSHO's policy was available prior to the state's then it would be considered. Mr. Brown will advise the National Ad Hoc committee of our situation here in Florida.

Marion Gilliam, chairman of the Space Allocation sub-committee, advised the group his committee would meet in the afternoon for further studies.

Bob Corn advised the committee that the utilities groups in Broward County, St. Petersburg and Orlando have changed their meeting dates. This will be reflected on the next issue of the Utility Calendar.

Gary Mitchell, chairman on the Color Code Identification sub-committee, reported that only one utility had answered his request for commenting on the proposed color scheme. After considerable discussion on the floor, Mr. Mitchell made a motion to adopt the color scheme proposed as a standard to be used when staking locations of existing or new facilities during construction of public works projects. The motion was seconded by Mr. Marion Gilliam and adopted by the Committee from a vote count taken by the show of hands. A copy of the color scheme is attached.

Mr. Karl Lohman reported for Mr. Glenn Fleischer, the Random Lay of telephone and power cables. Karl presented an excellent report, going into details on the various items that should be considered on the subject. Glenn Fleischer is preparing the study for the Telephone Engineer Workshop and the Committee would appreciate a copy upon its completion.

Under new business Bill Scheibe brought to the Committee's attention, problems involving conflicts with Outdoor Advertising Signs and rights involving tree trimming on road rights-of-way. In view of the work already undertaken by the District III Liaison Committee, chairman Reed requested that Bill Scheibe chair a sub-committee along with "Kemp" Kempson to advise him on what action should be taken.

Jim Tinsley advised the Committee that each member should obtain a copy of House Bill 234 which pertained to C.A.T.V. companies. Jim did not have a copy available but stated that it outlined their rights. Of particular interest is that they may have the right to force joint use of poles and regulate attachment fees.

Charles Batten also advised the Committee, House Bill 31 may be of interest to the utilities. This Bill deals with the Minimum Standard Building Code.

Following an excellent luncheon hosted by Florida Power Corporation, the meeting was adjourned.

The next meeting will be held at our regular meeting date of May 2, 1969. At this time the Committee can discuss and advise on the possibility of scheduling future meetings in conjunction with the American Right-of-Way Association. Bob Corn, Florida Gas and Transmission Company will host the meeting.
