The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman C. E. Hanle with 68 present. (Editor's note: The attached list has only 64 signatures.) Following the invocation by Ted Carlson, self-introductions were made.

The minutes of the meeting of February 6, 1981, were read and approved.

Announcements:

Chairman Hanle announced the next meeting would be at 9:00 a.m. on August 6, 1981, at the Indigo Inn, in Daytona Beach. Please note this meeting will be on a Thursday, and is in conjunction with the International Right-of-Way Association.

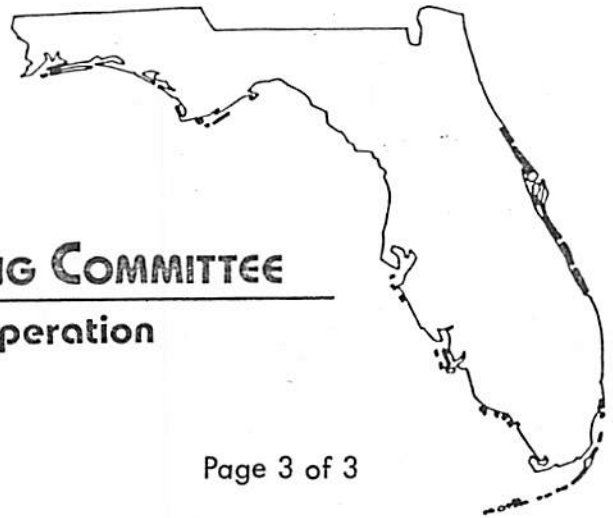
From the discussion, it was brought out that many are not aware that they are a part of the local coordinating group and participate in the discussions. Each District Committee should work on this.
