FALL MEETING
NOVEMBER 5, 1982
SHERATON YANKEE TRADER HOTEL
FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA

Chairman R. P. "Dick" Hall called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with 59 members present. Following the invocation and tribute to the Flag, self introductions were made (list attached).

The minutes of the August 5, 1982 meeting were read, corrected and approved.

Chairman Hall advised that there were no communications or announcements to be presented.

Chairman Hall called for reports from District Committees. Reports were received from the following:

District I - Dick McConville
District II - Kermit Dunwoody
District III - Jim Dunning
District IV - Jim Wright
District V - Curt Roane
District VI - Lee Spitzkopf

Chairman Hall asked for reports from all standing committees:

Curt Roane, Chairman of the Bike Path Committee, gave a report on previous committee activity and that Bicycle Facilities Planning and Design Workshops are scheduled for Orlando on December 6 and 7, in Tallahassee on December 8 and 10 and in Fort Lauderdale on December 13 and 14. Either Curt or Dick McConville will attend each workshop.

Dennis LaBelle, Co-Chairman of the Federal Highway Safety Committee, reviewed the purpose of his committee and advised members that there has been little activity since August - the Liaison Committee of the International Right of Way Association will meet in January, 1983.

Liaison Committee Chairman Dennis LaBelle distributed drafts of revised DOT Utility Liaison Procedure No. 722-051 which was the product of a Liaison Committee meeting in early October. This procedure deals with DOT liaison from corridor studies through construction, and outlines utility responsibilities as well. Should this revision be accepted by F.U.C.C. and DOT, additional DOT central and

office procedures must be revised.

There was an exchange of comments from the floor, concluding with Ted Carlson's recommendation that a vote be taken on this draft at the February, 1983 meeting.

Old Business -

Department of Natural Resources Easement Fees - Representatives from DNR were unable to attend this meeting, but Chairman Hall reported that there has been no decision on the attempt by DNR to arrive at a formula for calculating easement fees for users of State owned submerged land. No additional workshops were reported.

Roswell Sherling and Clyde Johnson expressed their concerns about the proposed fees.

Chairman Hall commented briefly on items of interest from recent DOT publications:

DOT Secretary Paul Pappas is new head of SASHTO (Southeastern Association of State Highway and Traffic Officials).

FDOT and Amtrack have entered into a contract to begin rail service in South Florida. The "Silver Palm" will commence intra state passenger service between Tampa and Miami on November 21.

New Business -

Overload Permits - Jim Dunning asked if any members had experienced any change in DOT policy concerning permits issued to haul large loads, specifically utility poles. Gulf Power Company indicated that they have encountered inconveniences in securing permits to move poles in excess of 55 foot length. No other similar problems were expressed and it was recommended that an inquiry be addressed to Mr. Billy Berry, DOT Tallahassee. Carter Holley agreed to contact Mr. Berry.

General discussion from the floor addressed various subjects:

Jeff Rodgers commented on the \$2M liability insurance requirement for gas pipeline crossings under railroad rights of ways; Larry Rice commented on dig-in problems and urged contractors to use available one-call centers; and Ed Gainey related a cable outage resulting from post hole diggers in the hands of a surveyor attempting to set a concrete monument.

Coffee Break - 10:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

Business resumed with Tom Priest introducing the guest speaker. Mr. Suheil E. (Jim) Jammal, P.E. is President and Chief Engineer of Jammal & Associates, Inc. of Winter Park, Florida. Mr. Jammal's company provides consulting engineering services in soils, foundations, earth structures, geohydrology, effluent disposal, site development studies and construction materials testing. His presentation covered Florida's sinkhole problem in general, and the Winter Park sinkhole in particular. Mr. Jammal's office is located within 500 feet of the Winter Park sinkhole and he had an excellent slide presentation documenting the various stages of sinkhole development. Mr. Jammal's personal interest and excellent exhibits

combined to make this a very informative program.

Chairman Hall made closing remarks and, just prior to adjourning, appointed Dick McConville to chair a Utilities Accommodation Guide Committee. Dick will form his committee prior to the next meeting.

The next meeting will be on February 4, 1983 in the Orlando area.
