



### **Coordination Through Cooperation**

SPRING MEETING MAY 6, 1983 HILTON HOTEL TAMPA, FLORIDA

Chairman R. P. "Dick" Hall called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with 81 members present. Following the invocation and tribute to the Flag, self introductions were made (list attached).

The members of the February 4, 1983 meeting were read and approved.

Tampa Electric Company hosted the meeting.

Chairman Hall read correspondence received by him since the previous meeting. Items of interest included: A One Call Symposium scheduled for June 26 - 29 in Washington, D.C.; Lump Sum reimbursement for DOT relocation projects has been increased to \$25,000; and our August meeting will be a joint meeting with the International Right of Way Association. The Florida Utilities Coordinating Committee will meet on Thursday, August 4, 1983. The joint meeting will extend from August 3 to 5.

Standing Committee Reports:

Bike Path Subcommittee: Curt Roane reported that there has been no subcommittee activity since the last meeting.

FHWA Safety Subcommittee: Dennis LaBelle reported no action in this area.

Joint Use Pole Subcommittee - Dennis LaBelle reported that DOT concerns over a indemnification paragraph in the Joint Project Agreement-Joint Pole Use have resulted in this subcommittee being re-activated. The indemnification provided by DOT is of extreme inportance to the utilities.

Utility Accommodation Guide: Dick McConville reported that he is awaiting a response from a letter to DOT requesting clarification of specific points in the Guide.

Old Business -

DNR Utility Easement Fee - The proposal to charge utilities for easements to cross State owned submerged land was scheduled as an agenda item for the May 17 meeting of the Governor and Cabinet. Chairman Hall also reported that DNR was considering alternative methods for setting the fees and in the length of the easement term. Jim Dunning was appointed as Subcommittee Chairman to monitor this easement fee proposal.

House Bill 80 - No further known action of this proposed legislation.

Coffee Break - 10:00 - 10:25 a.m.

Vice Chairman Tom Priest introduced Paul Riddell of Resource, Inc. who presented a program which discussed training methods and demonstrated computer similation. Mr. Riddell was assisted by Mrs. Joyce H. Hinson. Resource, Inc. is a privately held company which provides a variety of training courses which are of interest to the utility industry, and provides an outlet for a company wishing to market training programs which have been developed for company use.

New Business -

Dade County Ordinance - There was general discussion of this ordinance which requires someone to stand by outside a manhole at all times a worker is in the manhole. The outside person is required to have communications facilities and be trained in first aid. Jeff Rodgers commented that Senate Bill 538 proposes to impose similar requirements on a State-wide basis.

Chairman Hall covered a variety of legislative issues which were of general information.

The Vice Chairman and the Standing Committee were asked to recommend a slate of officers for the term beginning August, 1983. The Chairman and Vice Chairman offices are filled by progression, and the incoming Secretary will be elected at the August meeting from nominees of the Standing Committee and the general membership.

Chairman Hall introduced an American Heart Association fim entitled "Joe's Heart".

Chairman Hall extended the committee's appreciation to Tampa Electric Company for hosting the meeting, and adjourned the meeting at 12:00 Noon.

The next meeting will be held jointly with the International Right of Way Association Chapter 26 in Tampa - Our meeting will be held on Thursday, August 4.
