SUMMER MEETING AUGUST 4, 1983 BAY HARBOR INN TAMPA, FLORIDA

Chairman R. P. "Dick" Hall called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with 69 members present. Following the invocation and tribute to the Flag, self introductions were made (list attached).

The minutes of the May 6, 1983 meeting were read and approved.

General Telephone in Tampa hosted the meeting.

Chairman Hall read various communications received since the Spring Meeting. Items of special concern were conditions imposed in excess of the Utility Accommodation Guide , requiring testing of P.V.C. pipe at 50 P.S.I. rather than 20 P.S.I.; inconsistency in approving materials for castings and attachments to, and dialectric barriers required for bridge attachments; and failure of utility contractors in District One to meet DOT requirements of backfill, site clean-up and coordination with Department contractors.

Vice Chairman Tom Priest introduced Roy Leep, Director of Gulf Coast Weather Service and Director of WTVT Weather Service (Channel 13, Tampa). Mr. Leep described the various forecasting and weather gathering services which are available. He described "weathercasting services", ranging from rainfall forecasting for a construction project in Venezuela to recording the incidence and location of lightening strikes in central Florida.

Chairman Hall acquainted the committee with the agenda for the International Right of Way Association - Chapter 26 Summer Seminar on August 4 and 5.

Standing Committee Reports:

Bike Path Subcommittee Chairman Curt Roane reported on the 1983 Floria Bike Safety Statute which was signed into law by Governor Graham on June 3, 1983.

Utility Liaison Procedures Subcommittee Chairman Dennis LaBelle reported that he will submit revised DOT Utility Liaison Procedure No. 722-051, which was approved by the general membership at the Winter meeting, for DOT consideration.

Joint Use Pole Subcommittee Chairman Dennis LaBelle reported that further negotiations with DOT will be required to resolve this issue.

DNR Subcommittee Chairman Jim Dunning reported that the proposal to charge fees for utility easements across State owned submerged land should be resolved at the September 6, 1983 Cabinet meeting. DNR has been asked to submit a new fee proposal.

Standing Committee Chairman Tom Priest reported on the August 3 meeting.

Coffee Break - 10:40 - 11.00 a.m.

Chairman Hall introduced Paul Kaczorowski, State Right of Way Administrator, who commented on DOT reorganization and expressed his interest in participating in future Committee meetings. He also commented that the Joint Use Pole problem will be addressed and that internal DOT liaison efforts will be advanced. Mr. Kaczorowski introduced Assistant Right of Way Administrator, Dallas Gray.

Jim Fuller of MCI Telecommunications reported that a survey will commence in two weeks to locate utilities on the Seaboard Systems Railroad right of way between Orlando and Tampa. He introduced Sam Weaver of the Route Development Division who will work with the various utility notification centers.

Charlie Kimbrell reported that notification centers U.U.N.C and U.N.C.L.E. will be merged by the end of this year.

New Business -

The Federal Highway Administration is implementing a program entitled Facilitate Acceleration through Special Techniques (FAST). Minimum information is available at this time, but under FAST the States are encouraged to take steps to advance selected highway projects. Utilities will be requested to help expedite arrangements needed to adjust their facilities.

Chairman Hall expressed his appreciation to Committee officers, subcommittee members and the general membership for support received during his term. He then dissolved all committees to allow the incoming chairman to make appointments.

Vice Chairman Priest presented the Standing Committee's nomination of Dick McConville for Secretary. Since the Chairman and Vice Chairman positions are filled by progression, the slate of officers presented by the nominating committee were:

Chairman - Tom Priest Vice Chairman - Jim Dunning Secretary - Dick McConville

There was a motion and a second that nominations be closed, motion passed.

Ted Carlson made a motion that the Secretary cast a single unanimous ballot for each of the officers, the motion received a second and then passed. The Secretary then cast the ballot. Incoming Chairman Tom Priest then presented a plaque to outgoing Chairman Dick Hall, in recognition of his contribution to the Florida Utilities Coordinating Committee.
