



FALL MEETING NOVEMBER 4, 1983 HOLIDAY INN PENSACOLA BEACH, FLORIDA



Chairman, Tom Priest, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with fifty-two (52) members present. Following the invocation and tribute to the Flag, self introduction was made (list attached), Minutes of the August 4, 1983 meeting in Tampa were read and approved as correct.

Gulf Power Company hosted the meeting.

Chairman Priest read correspondence received since the previous meeting. A letter was received from W. M. Hellard, Director, Division of Maintenance, regarding the testing of PVC pipe. There have been no changes in the Utility Accommodations Guide PVC pipe requires testing at 20 PSI. Mr. Hillard has circulated a bulletin advising the DOT District Offices regarding this issue. Items of interest in legislation, House Bill 40, an act relating to community redevelopment agencies readjustment, relocation of public services facilities. Federal Register Review: Accommodation of Utilities 45 FR26280, Review: Utility Relocation Adjustments and Reimbursement 44 FR12209 and 45 FR76924. If you are interested in this legislation, it is suggested that you obtain a copy from the appropriate source.

W. L. Anderson introduced Larry Sessions, Bridge Inspection and Evaluation Engineer, DOT, Tallahassee. Mr. Sessions spoke on the Utility Accommodations Guide as it pertains to bridge attachments. He reviewed the current procedure for placing utilities on bridges and was seeking council of the Committee regarding future direction. An extended discussion period followed his presentation.

A meeting was held prior to the Standing Committee of fourteen (14) representatives from Electric Power Companies. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss items of common interest and concern in the Electric Power industry, reported Vice Chairman Jim Dunning. He is encouraging the establishing of similar groups by other industries or agencies represented in the FUCC. See your Standing Committee representative for additional information.

Vice Chairman, Jim Dunning, introduced Ray Harry, Supervisor of Environmental Licensing for Gulf Power Company. Mr. Harry presented the issue of Acid Rain in great depth, the historical significants, current status and future trends. "Care must be exercised to prevent the rate payer from being saddled with unnecessary and ineffective controls and safeguards", he said.

Utility Liaison Procedure Subcommittee Chairman, Dennis LaBelle, reported that changes have been made in the revised DOT Utility Liaison Procedure No. 722-051, removing railroads from the procedure. A copy of the procedure will be sent to Paul Kaczosowski for review.

Joint Use Pole Subcommittee Chairman, Dennis LaBelle reported that a meeting was held with J. Anderson, attorney for the DOT. Mr. Anderson suggested that a statewide insurance policy be written to cover liability on joint use poles rather than establishing an indemnity section because they are having difficulty in preparing one. Additional information on this subject should be available at the next meeting.

FHWP Safety Subcommittee, Dennis LaBelle, reported the State of Illinois has addressed the subject of hazardous poles and have prepared a publication of these findings. Write Illinois DOT, 2300 South Dirken Parkway, Springfield, Illinois 62742, if you would like a copy. Dennis reported that the Transportation Code is being revised by the Legislative Committee on Transportation in cooperation with the Department of Transportation. The proposed rewrite of Chapters 336 and 337 of the Florida Status are of concern to all of us. Chairman Tom Priest established a subcommittee to review the rewrite and report to the Committee.

Utility Accommodations Guide Subcommittee Chairman, Dick McConville, reported that he has not received a reply from his letter of April 14, 1983, to J. W. Roberts, Utility Maintenance Engineer. Mr. Marshall L. Stivers will check with Mr. Roberts regarding the status of his reply.

DNR Subcommittee Chairman, Jim Dunning, advised there has been no further action on the proposed fee.

Chairman, Tom Priest, introduced Marshall L. Stivers, Engineer of Roadway Maintenance Operations, DOT, Tallahassee. Mr. Stivers spoke on the Utility Accommodations Guide. The Guide gives all of use the flexibility to modify the procedures when all parties are in agreement. Any changes introduced by the DOT will be given sufficient time to be reviewed by this Committee before it is put into effect. He said there are no plans to revise the Utility Accommodations Guide at this time.

Chairman Priest called for final remarks and announced the intent to meet in South Florida on February 3, 1984. He extended the Committees' appreciation to Gulf Power for hosting the meeting and adjourned the meeting at 12:00 noon.
