Summer Meeting, August 3, 1984 Sundial Beach and Tennis Resort Sanibel Island, Florida

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Tom Priest at 9:00 a.m. with fifty-eight members present. Following the invocation and tribute to the Flag, self introduction was made (list attached). Minutes of the May 3, 1984 meeting in Tallahassee were read and approved.

Lee County Electric Cooperative hosted the meeting.

Chairman, Tom Priest, received reports from District Representatives.

Chairman Priest read correspondence received since the previous meeting. letter was received from the Secretary of Transportation, Mr. P. N. Pappas, regarding senior management appointments in the Department of Transportation. A letter was received from Lee A Spitzkopf requesting a subcommittee be established to study the Private Line issue.

Chariman Priest received reports from subcommittee chairmen. Utility Liaison Procedure Subcommittee Chairman, Dennis LaBelle, reported the Utility Liaison Procedure has been returned by the DOT and was reviewed by the subcommittee. The Steering Committee recommended that the DOT expand the procedure to include all the departments in the DOT. As it is presently written, the procedure involves one department. Dennis was instructed by the General Committee to write to the Dept. of Transportation to advise them of the Committee's request to expand the Utility Liaison Precedure to include all departments in the DOT.

Joint Use Pole Subcommittee Chairman, Dennis LaBelle, reported that progress has been made in the joint use pole indemnity section and it appears that an insurance attachment cost of \$5.00 per pole will be proposed by the department.

Utility Accommodations Subcommittee Chairman, Dick McConville, reported on the subcommittee meeting held May 19 at the FPL Building, Sarasota. The subcommittee met to review the policy of the DOT regarding the Utility Accommodations Guide when resurfacing, restoring and rehabilitating streets and highways. Assignments were made to subcommittee members to review certain DOT Manuals and codes as they pertain to the Utility Accommodations Guide.

Seminar Subcommittee Chairman, Jim Dunning, reported negotiations are in progress for a joint meeting between the IRWA and FUCC, November 8 and 9 in Orlando. Chairman Tom called for a motion to change the November meeting date—it was moved and seconded. A majority of the members voted in favor.

Jan Klatt, Call Candy, reported Governor Bob Graham had declared August 15-25 as "Call Before you Dig" week and has issued a proclamation. The purpose is to urge both private citizens and contractors to call the one call number in their area before digging, blasting, boring or disturbing the earth's subsurface. Jan urged all utility companies in the state to get behind this worthwhile program.

Chairman, Tom Priest, reported the Standing Sub-committee has requested the time of their meeting be changed from 5:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. A motion was made and seconded--all members present voted in favor.

Roswell Sherling reported on the meeting of the Electric Power group meeting held prior to the Standing Committee--thirteen (13) members were in attendance.

Coffee Break - 10:00 a.m. - 10:15 a.m.

Bill Ventry introduced Mr. William W. Miller, Jr., Deputy Assistant Secretary in charge of operations. Mr. Miller spoke on the reorganization of the DOT and the past, present and future prospect of transportation in Florida. There will be no additions to the interstate system. The maintenance of highway will be expanded. High speed rail transportation is the transportation of the future. He urged everyone to review new transportation code 237.12 as it will affect the utility companies as well as the Department of Transportation.

Dick McConville introduced the honorable Fred Dudley, member of the Florida House of Representatives representing District 74. Mr. Dudley welcomed all the members present to the beautiful City of Sanibel, one of the first cities to adopt the comprehensive land usage plan in the State of Florida. He spoke on the rewrite of the transportation code. It was the largest bill filed in the 1984 legislature. He felt it was a good bill. Mr. Dudley was asked what was the most pressing problem facing Southwest Florida today and he said the availability of an adequate supply of drinking water.

Chairman, Tom Priest, presented the new officers in accordance with the by-laws for the ensuing year: Chairman, J. L. "Jim" Dunning, Gulf Power Company. Vice Chairman, R. J. "Dick" McConville, United Telephone Company. The Standing Subcommittee nominated Mr. Mike Flanery, Pinellas County Water System as secretary. He was elected by unanimous ballot.

Chairman, Tom Priest, turned the meeting over to incoming Chairman Jim Dunning. Chairman Jim read the following list (see attachment) of nominees for subcommittees for 1984-1985.

Chairman Dunning presented Tom Priest with a plaque from the membership for his outstanding year as Chairman of the F.U.C.C.

Chairman, Jim Dunning, called for final remarks and announced the intent to meet in Orlando on November 8 and 9. He extended the committee's appreciation to the Lee County Electric Cooperative for hosting the meeting and providing coffee and pastries. The meeting was adjourned at 11:50 a.m.
