Fall Meeting, November 9, 1984

Joint Meeting With Florida Chapter 26, IR/WA
Radisson Inn, Kissimmee, Florida

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jim Dunning at 9:00 a.m. with eighty members present (list attached). The meeting was opened by the Salute to the Flag and an Invocation given by Ted Carlson. Self introductions were made. Minutes of the August 3, 1984 meeting were approved as read.

The following Subcommittee reports were given:

Utility Liaison Procedure Chairman Dennis LaBelle reported no significant activity.

Joint Use Pole Chairman Dennis LaBelle reported no significant activity.

Manuals and Guides Review Chairman Dick McConville reported that one meeting had been held and another is scheduled for Nov. 14, 1984. No information to report.

Private Facilities Study Chairman Lee Spitzkopf has a meeting scheduled Dec. 4, 1984

Manual of Uniform Standards for Design, Construction and Maintenance of Streets and Highways ["The Green Book"] - State of Florida Chairman, Ted Carlson, stated that it was clarified that on Aug. 28, 1984 by letter from Dave Bullard the FUCC had been invited to have one non-voting observer attend the State Green Book Revision Advisory Committee Meeting. Ted advised that to get a copy of the current Revision 3 of the Green Book contact the Florida D.O.T., Maps and Publication Division, Hayden Burns Bldg., 605 Suwannee St., Tallahassee. The cost was unknown. Any members seeking change in the Green Book should contact Ted Carlson.

Reports on Standing Subcommittee Group Meetings held on November 7, 1984:

Power Group Chairman, Ron Worley, reported there were nineteen in attendance and the topic was primarily the Dallas Gray letter regarding tree trimming on D.O.T. rights-of ways.

Telephone Group Chairman, George McWicker, reported there were 12 attendees who met and discussed Joint Use Permitting.

D.O.T. Group, represented by Jim Hanie, reported that 13 members met all day.

Chairman Dunning commented on the excellent response to the Group Meetings, to which there were forty-four attendees.

Reports from District Representatives were requested by Chairman Dunning.

District I Walter Childs, reported that there are two new local groups - Lakeland and Pasco (Dade City)

District II - Curt Roane
District III - Charles Andrews

District V - Jim Hanie District VI - A. B. Dasher

District IV - Jim Wright

Jim Hanie introduced Charles Stratton, Chief of the Eminent Domain Section of the Right-of-Way Dept. of the Florida D.O.T., who discussed Florida D.O.T. condemnation powers and procedures and aquisition of land for public utility use. He commented that D.O.T. is emphasizing buying Right-of-ways instead of condemning them and that procedures for joint litigation and joint condemnation are being considered. He noted FS 335.101 makes unauthorized removal of or damage to trees and other vegetation a 2nd degree misdemeanor. He invited FUCC members to contact him for help in D.O.T. condemnation problems.

Coffee Break.

Dick McConville then introduced David G. Proctor, Assistant Vice President of AT&T Communications. Mr. Proctor explained that his company is now only approximately 20% the size before "breakup", and about 80% of their revenues go back to local exchanges. AT&T is in a difficult competitive situation because AT&T is regulated by the PSC, while MCI and others are not, and because access charges are often based on previous subsidies, not on actual costs.

Chairman Dunning advised that the D.O.T. Representative position on the Standing Sub-committee became vacant with the promotion of Bill Ventry, and the Telephone Representative vacancy occurred with Herb Overstreet leaving. He asked that Ken Towcimak, the new State Right-of-way Administrator be approved as Florida D.O.T. Representative and that George McWicker be approved as the Telephone Representative. This request was moved and approved by the Committee.

In regard to the tree trimming issue the D.O.T. would like the FUCC to respond to previous correspondence and Chairman Dunning asked that instead of setting up a new subcommittee, that the Power Group under Chairman Ron Worley prepare a response with George McWicker, Telephone Group Chairman, and Richard Nowling, Tampa Cable Television, asked to make their input. It was therefore moved and approved that Chairman Dunning respond to Dallas Gray's letter in the four areas of tree trimming, tree removal, mowing and use of herbicides with more specifics to be presented later.

Chairman Dunning explained to new members of the group the finances and membership of the group, expressed thanks to speakers and others involved; and gave special thanks to IR/WA Officers, Tim Mumford and Derrick Vardy for their efforts in setting up this joint meeting and for taking care of the FUCC accompdations. The meeting was adjourned at 11:45 a.m.
