

Summer Meeting, August 2, 1985 Florida Utility Coordinating Committee Joint Meeting with Florida Chapter 26, IR/WA Adam's Mark Caribbean Gulf Resort, Clearwater Beach, Florida

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jim Dunning at 9:05 a.m. Sixtytwo members were in attendance (attendance list attached). The meeting was opened with the Salute to the Flag, the invocation by Ted Carlson, and self introductions. Minutes of the May 2, 1985 meeting were approved as read.

District Reports were given by:

OLD BUSINESS:

Chairman Dunning advised of recent publication by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal Register regarding the accommodation of utilities in right-of-ways, 23 CFR part 645, May 15, 1985, Vol. 50 #94.

A letter from Ken Towcimak, Chief, Bureau of Right-of-Way, advises that the current Joint Pole Agreement will not need to be revised. Also a letter was sent to Mr. Towcimak advising the DOT of recommended safe practices in check-ing of power line heights.

GROUP MEETINGS:

<u>Power</u>: Ron Worley reported 13 attended from six companies. Discussed problems they were having locating their facilities in DOT Right-of-Way, especially in limited access areas, and the proposed changes for bridge attachments.

<u>Telephone</u>: George McWicker -- 18 in attendance, discussed utility process task force and ways telephone industry could contribute to speeding up construction.

DOT: Jerry Sasser -- 11 in attendance, several items covered, active meeting.

Jim Dunning asked that possibly an underground group be established.

Liaison Subcommittee: Dennis LaBelle -- Subcommittee will be disbanded and made part of the Utility Accommodations Guide Review Subcommittee.

Joint Pole Subcommittee: Dennis LaBelle -- This subcommittee has been disbanded.

<u>Green Book Subcommittee</u>: Ted Carlson -- Unofficial report given of the committee that was appointed by the Governor, which he attends as an ex officio member, but Ted asked that it not be made part of the official record. He did comment, however, that he was impressed that all individuals including the district engineers, design engineers, and consultants worked very diligently, reviewed matters in detail, and rubber stamped nothing.

<u>Guides and Manual Subcommittee</u>: Dick McConville -- The major item facing the subcommittee is bridge attachments. If any members have concerns regarding the requirement that all bridge attachments be approved by a professional engineer with both structural and corrosion engineering expertise, send your comments to Utility Accomodations Guide Committee. The Guides and Manual Subcommittee has been disbanded and made part of the Utility Accommodations Guide Subcommittee.

<u>Construction Contract Time Task Force</u>: Ken Brown -- Last meeting held in Miami on July 16, many topics were discussed, a copy of the draft report has recently been received, and is being reviewed.

Private Facilities Subcommittee: No report.

#### SPEAKERS:

Carlos F. Stone, Executive Director, Florida Transportation Builders Association, Inc. spoke regarding contractor/utilities coordination. Discussed how historically there has always been need to cooperate, the pressures on the contractor to avoid liquidated damages that can now be as high as \$10,000/day, extra problems as more work is being done in urban areas, increases in liability and litigation, and Senator Jack Gordon's recent request to cut construction time in half. Mr. Stone urges that coordination begin at the earliest stage possible. He will try to get contractors and others to participate in utility coordination meetings, and asked that he receive copies of any district or local meetings. Mr. Stone can be contacted at P.O. Box 1208, Tallahassee, FL 32302, Phone (904) 222-1795. His office is in the lower lobby of the Downtown Tallahassee Holiday Inn.

John DeWinkler, District I Director of Production, substituted by Mr. Tom Drawdy. He discussed implementation of utility corridors, and possible procedures and considerations that need to be addressed if they are set up. He recognized that utilities are as much a part of the transportation system as the automobiles. The Legislature has removed DOT right-of-way acquisition from the sunshine laws. A law was passed that lets the DOT file for future rights-of-way needs and allows local agencies to withhold building permits in those areas. Also, the Secretary of Transportation will be able to "announce" a project, thereby freezing the value of the land. Attorneys will be more accountable for their time. The Legislature restored the estimated shortfall in revenue, which keeps the construction schedule on track. The Local Assistance Act gave County Government a 2 cent tax for local roads.

Florida Utility Coordinating Committee - Minutes August 2, 1985 3

Reorganization of DOT makes Tallahassee responsible for policy, procedure, and monitoring programs. District offices will be responsible to carry out those policies and procedures. Deputy District Secretaries are now accountable and have responsibility and authority to carry out district business. An organization chart was distributed. A 7th district was not authorized, but local offices are being set up in the Tampa Bay Area, Fort Myers, West Palm, Melbourne, Orlando, and Jacksonville.

NEW BUSINESS:

Election of Officers: Dick McConville placed into consideration from the Nominating Committee Roswell Sherling for Secretary. The nominations of R. J. (Dick) McConville for Chairman, Mike Flanery for Vice Chairman, and Roswell Sherling for Secretary were approved unanimously.

Jim thanked all for the help and support he had received this year and expressed the pride he takes in the group. He turned the meeting over to Dick, whereupon Dick presented him with a plaque representing the appreciation from the group for his excellent leadership during the past year.

Dick McConville then appointed members to the standing committees. Dennis LaBelle suggested, and it was approved, that a committee be formed to investigate an awards program for companies, agencies, or groups that do the most to promote what the FUCC stands for -- utility coordination.

The August 1986 joint FUCC/IRWA meeting will be held in Daytona.

At the request of Chairman McConville the next meeting will be held in the Ocala area if possible.

Derrick Vardy expressed his appreciation for the cooperation of the FUCC in holding the joint meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:45 a.m.
