Summer Meeting, August 8, 1986
Florida Utilities Coordinating Committee
Joint Meeting with Florida Chapter 26, IR/WA
Indigo Lakes Conference Center, Daytona Beach, Florida

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Dick McConville at 9:00 a.m. Sixty-three members were in attendance (attendance list attached). The meeting was opened with the Salute to the Flag, the invocation by Ted Carlson, and self-introductions.

Minutes of the May 2, 1986 meeting were approved as read by Roswell Sherling.

Chairman McConville introduced the first speaker, Thomas E. Drawdy, Secretary of the Florida Department of Transportation. Mr. Drawdy thanked the Utility Process Task Force for their input on problems which were addressed by the FDOT and revisions were made resulting into a better document for all those concerned. Mr. Drawdy expressed the major concern of the heavy growth of Florida and its effect on needed projects, and Florida's ability to fund these projects with monies presently available. Florida has the third largest spending budget but, per capita, is proportionately low.

Mr. Drawdy said that there is a problem with contracts not being completed on time. Delays are sometimes caused by FDOT and by contractors requiring utility relocation. The DOT is presently working on many ways to improve, including a law regarding eminent domain. FDOT will concentrate on preliminary engineering, recognizing that this is the key to good planning. Questions and answers followed.

Subcommittee Reports:

Telephone - Tom Duggar reported on the DOT Process Task Force, the rewrite of the Accommodations Guide and recommended a subcommittee on fiber optics.

Power - Ed Garcia reported that they discussed the Accommodations Guide and recommended a subcommittee for foreign attachments to poles (third party).

DOT - Richard Hurst gave a report on the task force, the indemnification clause and utility coordination on new structures (joint use).

Utility Notification - Jan Klatt reported that the computer data base is being prepared.

Underground - Pat Cassalia reported on jack and bore procedures and discussed plans for the next year.

Governor's Green Book - Ted Carlson reported that they have not had a recent meeting.

Accommodations Guide - Ted Carlson thanked all the committee members that worked very hard on this guide to make it a success. A handout was available.

Task Force - Lee Spitzkopf thanked the members for their participation. A handout entitled "Utility Process Task Force Study to Reduce Construction Contract Time" was available.

Private Facility - Lee Spitzkopf recommended that this subcommittee be disbanded since the task was completed. A summary was available.

After the subcommittee reports, Thomas Drawdy, Secretary of FDOT, presented the Malcolm Yancey Award to Ted Carlson. Ted is retiring after many years of dedicated service to the F.U.C.C. He will be truly missed.

The next speaker was Dan Thilen, Safety Inspector for Bell Laboratories in Atlanta. He presented an interesting and informative program on fiber optics. Mr. Thilen has had much experience in research in this area. He have a demonstration on laser beams and discussed the safety aspects.

The next speaker, Dennis Graves, lobbyist for General Telephone at the Florida Legislature, spoke on the 1986 legislative session in Tallahassee. Mr. Graves informed us of bills presented that affect utilities, especially telephone companies. A very interesting update on possible law changes that could materially affect utilities policy and operations. Mr. Graves' talk made us all aware of the importance of representation in Tallahassee.

Chairman McConville presented an award to Dennis Labelle as the outstanding liaison person of the year.

Chairman McConville recognized Jim Dunning, Bob Lingenfelter and Clyde Cheeks for their assistance in coordinating the meetings for the FUCC and IR/WA. Dick then dissolved his committees for the past year.

Jim Dunning established the new Awards Committee with the following members: Jan Klatt, Bill Garrett, Larry Rice and George McWicker.

Chairman McConville thanked everyone for their effort during the past year and turned the meeting over to Mike Flanery who will be the Chairman for the coming year. Roswell Sherling will be the Vice Chairman. Ray Afeld was the nominee for Secretary and was unanimously approved.

The next quarterly meeting will be held on November 7, 1986. The Fort Lauderdale area was suggested.

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
There was no old business.
