The meeting was called to order at 8:40 a.m. by Chairman Roswell Sherling. The Invocation was offered by Mr. Bill Garrett. A Salute to the Flag and self-introductions opened the meeting. Eighty-two members and guest were in attendance (list attached).

Mike Crumpton introduced Mr. Bob Haven, Chief Administrative officer of the City of Orlando who welcomed the F.U.C.C. to the "City Beautiful."

The Historian report was given by Bill Garrett. Bill read excerpts from 11-9-62 (25 years ago). Due to the agenda, an abbreviated minutes of the August meeting was read by Rick Nowling. The minutes were approved as read with one spelling correction.

Mike Crumpton introduced the next speaker, Mr. David Zeno City of Orlando who presented the group with an excellent slide presentation and discussion of the recently completed Street-Scape on Orange Street in downtown Orlando. Mr. Zeno discussed in detail the various methods used to work the project. A question and answer period followed this most interesting talk.

Vice Chairman Patricia Cassalia introduced the next speaker, Mr. R. Eugene Rocque of the NASA Shuttle Operations Mission Planning Office. Mr. Rocque gave an excellent slide presentation on the Space program. Some of the areas covered were the Space Center, various rockets used over the past years, the shuttle and future vehicles to be used. A question and answer period also followed this most enjoyable presentation.

Steering Committee Report

Vice Chairman Patricia Cassalia gave the Steering Committee Report for the meeting which was held the previous day. Highlights included future meetings with the IRWA; future meeting locations, an F.D.O.T. workshop on T/2 project; and the fiber optics sub-committee work. Dallas Pryor made a motion to the membership that the State provide a follow-up workshop pertaining to the Contract Construction Task Force Report recommendations to reduce the time it takes to complete a project by 50% (T/2), Mr. Dick McConville seconded and motion passed unanimously.

In regards to future joint meetings with the IRWA a motion was made and passed to send a letter to the IRWA sustaining the Liasion Breakfast and keep our ties but hold no future joint sessions with them.

Sub-committee meetings dates were the next item presented. It is the recommendation of the committee that no sub-committee meetings shall be held during the F.U.C.C. meeting dates unless extremely important. There was no discussion of this.

The next meeting of the F.U.C.C. for 1988 will be:

February - Miami; May - Tallahassee; August - Jacksonville

Roswell read a letter from Bill Anderson who retired from the D.O.T. November 1, 1987, after a 31 year career. Roswell praised Bill for his work and being a "true friend" to the F.U.C.C.. A formal letter will be sent to Bill signed by the officers of the F.U.C.C. for this recognition.

Roswell then appointed a new committee to work on the F.D.O.T. address book. Mr. Jim Gibbs will chair the committee. Members include Mike Crumpton, C.J. Blanton and Rocy DePrimo. Please contact Jim if wishing to serve on this committee.

Interest Group Reports (From 11-5-87)

Underground Sub-Committee - Dallas Pryor gave the underground report. Items discussed were a statement regarding mandatory utility notification by contractors and the APWA Utility Council up-coming "Congress" in Orlando.

Power/Telephone/Cable-TV - Dennis LaBelle gave the report on the joint meeting in which 39 members were present. Topics covered were break-away poles; 3R "Clear Zone" projects; and the use of interstate rights of ways for fiber optic cables.

F.D.O.T. - Paul Kaczorowski gave the report on the D.O.T.'s meeting in which 11 attended. The problems with the accelerated work program; the use of consultants; a need for clarity on inspections of construction activity where more than one party is on the job, and joint project agreements were discussed. Paul spoke on the Task Force Report. Some 30 recommendations came out of the report. The items directly related to time have been dispersed of, i.e. implemented, rule-changes, etc... A final report of these activities will be given in January 1988 by the State to the Transportation Research Board in Washington. However, Paul emphasized that much more work is needed between the D.O.T. and the F.U.C.C. in these areas.

Paul reported on the meeting with the Secretary in Tampa on 9-18-87. There were 42 in attendance. The message was the commitment of the D.O.T. to an accelerated work program.

Paul also reported on a grant the State is negotiating with the University of Florida on the use of rights of way for placing fiber optic cables in limited access areas. A letter went out from this group focusing on revenues being obtained from these facilities. Paul pointed out that the Department is not looking at revenues for this.

In other business, Chairman Sherling re-activated the fiber optics sub-committee with John Farkus as chairman. Members include Pat Eagen, Tom Duggar, Gene McMath, Dick McConville, Carl Froling and Jim Bates.

The Treasures Report was given by Vice Chairman Patricia Cassalia. The current balance is \$661.21 carried over from last meeting. A motion passed for the suspension of registration fees for the next meeting.

Pat also acknowledged and congratulated Mr. Walt Childs, Jr. who was appointed District Utilities Engineer for District 1.

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Pat thanked Mike Crumpton for his help in setting up the meeting.

One Call Utility Notification Centers

Jan Klatt announced to the Committee that in August 1987, General Telephone Co. announced that due to economics and liabilities they would not continue to staff the "Call Candy" center. This information was brought through a Board meeting. None of the other members wished to staff the office so the center will be put out for bid.

John Shelton reported to the Committee as of December 1987 "UNCLE" has 60 of 67 counties in their data base.

Dennis LaBelle made comments on a manual available titled "Selection of Cost Effective Countermeasures With Utility Pole Accidents" from the FHWA. Call or write Jim Carney.

Also, the IRWA liasion Committee is developing a utility manual in conjunction with the FHWA. They are looking at developing a bi-annual utility road agency national committee.

With no further business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned at 11:45 a.m..
