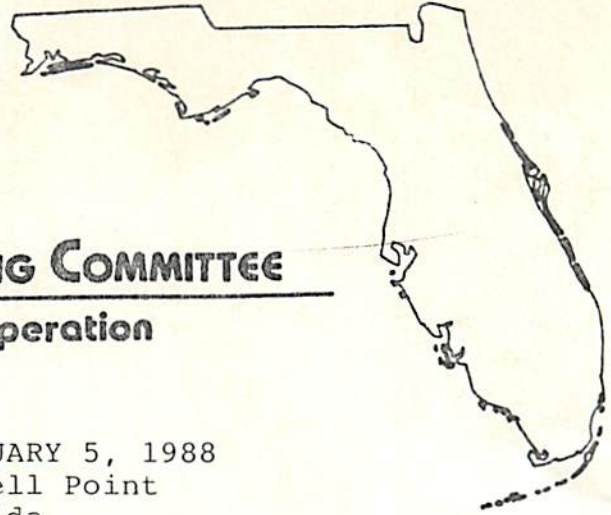

WINTER MEETING, FEBRUARY 5, 1988  
Sheraton at Brickell Point  
Miami, Florida

The meeting was called to order at 8:42 a.m. by chairman Roswell Sherling. The Invocation was offered by Mr. Bill Garrett. A Salute to the Flag and self-introductions opened the meeting. Eighty-five members and guest were in attendance (list attached).

The Historian report was given by Bill Garrett. Bill read excerpts from FUCC meetings held on March 17, 1938 (50 years ago) and February 23, 1963 (25 years ago).

A.B. Dasher introduced Mr. Guy Sanchez, General Manager FP&L, City of Miami, District Office.

Guy welcomed our most special guest Mayor Xavier Suarez who welcomed the group to the Beautiful City of Miami.

Mayor Suarez gave the group an overview of the area and its efforts to keep up with the tremendous growth being experienced.

The next item on the agenda was a panel discussion on the treatment of road side obstacles. Paul Kaczorowski, P.E., F.D.O.T. State Utilities Engineer moderated the panel.

Deborah Reaves, Director, Technology Transfer Center, University of Florida, began the discussion on the clear zone concept and research being done in this area. A slide presentation along with a video on "Vehicular Behavior" was presented. The Technology Transfer Center has a library of information relative to these areas. Next, Dennis LaBelle discussed the various manuals currently in use. The 3-R manual, Green Book, Index 700, and the Utility Accomodation Guide were briefly covered and it was pointed out that they are not consistent in regards to placements of facilities.

The third panelist was Dave Bullard, Chief of Roading Design F.D.O.T., who presented the group with the idea that 3 sets of standards be adopted for road projects. One for new construction, one for re-construction and one for re-surfacing are being proposed. Each of these areas were covered and attached to the minutes are the proposed clear zone standards for 3R projects. The revised 3R manual is due out in March or April of this year. This is a very difficult issue and Mr. Bullard was recognized for his efforts in these areas at the national level to find solutions to these very complex issues.

A question and answer period followed the panel discussion.

Foreign Attachments To Poles Sub-Committee - Report was given by Chris Bell. Representatives from 3 power companies, 2 telephone companies and 6 cable companies. A clear need for identification was a consensus at this meeting. Alternative ways were discussed that would be uniform statewide. If anyone wants to serve on this committee please contact Chris at Florida Power Corp.

Fiber Optics Sub-Committee - John Farkes reported to the group a set of standards was presented to Roswell Sherling. John acknowledged the committee and asked for these standards to be adopted at the May FUCC meeting in Tallahassee. (Copy attached to minutes.)

F.D.O.T. Address Book Sub-Committee - Jim Gibbs reported on their progress. A draft is expected in the Fall of this year.

Steering Committee - Vice Chairman Patricia Cassalia gave the report on the steering committee which met Thursday afternoon in which 16 people attended. Some note worthy items include:

1. A \$5.00 registration fee will be charged at the May meeting.
2. The May meeting will be held May 12 and 13, 1988 at the Tallahassee Hilton Hotel.
3. Interest Groups need to address 2 issues - As built; requirements for D.O.T. projects and the criteria that utilities need at the 60% stage to process their plans versus the 90% level.

The Treasurers report was also given. The current balance from the last meeting in Orlando is \$452.08.

Pat also thanked Dennis LaBelle for his help in setting up the meeting and Paul Kaczorowski for the workshop on Thursday.

The two letters referenced in the November minutes have not been sent yet but will be forthcoming.

Rick Nowling also presented to the steering committee impending legislation with respect to the Department of Natural Resources charging fees for use of their rights of ways.


In other business, Chairman Sherling appointed Jim Haynie as the representative for consultants on the steering committee. He replaces Jim Hunt.

Roswell also thanked A.B. Dasher, Dennis LaBelle and the hotel staff for a successful meeting.

As a last order of business an amended motion was passed with respect to the aforementioned DNR fee assesment to CATV companies. Each utility will respond on their own to this issue and not as a lobbying effort of the FUCC.

With no further business to conduct the meeting was adjourned at 11:45 a.m.
