

R. P. "Bob" Brown, Corrosion Engineer, Department of Transportation, presented a most informative talk and slide presentation on corrosion as related to utility and highway structures.

Upon the report of the Nominating Committee, the following officers were elected for the ensuing year.

Vern Brown, Sub-committee Chairman on Utility Space Allocation, passed out the Committee's finalized copy of study on space allocation for review by members of the FUCC with the suggestion that the report be brought up for vote at the November meeting.

Kemp Kempson, Sub-committee Chairman on the F.D.O.T. Accommodation Guide, reported on meeting of the sub-committee held on August 3, 1972 in Pensacola and reviewed committee's recommended changes. Following this review and incorporating changes from the floor, Mr. Kempson made the motion that the Chairman of the FUCC request to the DOT that we be granted sufficient time for future review before this guide be submitted for Public hearing and that additionally the Chairman arrange for a meeting with officials of the DOT to discuss recommended changes.

Kemp-Kempson, Sub-committee Chairman on the "Overhanging Signs and Canopies", made a motion to recommend the attached resolution be adopted by the FUCC and that the Chairman of the FUCC initiate a letter to the heads of all municipal and county governments in Florida requesting them take the necessary and appropriate action, relative to this resolution, which would prevent any future conflicts, as have been encountered in the past, between the overhead utility industry and the Outdoor Sign and Canopy Industry. It was also recommended that the Chairman point out in his letter the exact nature of some of these conflicts, citing the main one as being the necessity of utilities having to overgrade 40 to 80 feet signs; thereby, creating additional expenses which eventually the rate payer will have to pay.

FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION UPDATE - Ken Weldon

Mr. Weldon, State Utility Engineer, mentioned that the FDOT had created a Survey Form which represents a list of activities currently being pursued. The State Utility Office would like for individuals and/or representatives of the utility agencies to use this survey form as means to let the State Utility Office the priority (in which that particular firm/agency) would like to them addressed, A "I" would have the highest priority. The Survey Form is to be completed and returned by August 15, 1997 to the State Utility Office. He also mentioned that proposals are due September 1, 1997.

Mr. Weldon referred to the first item on the survey form which was In-Forms Issues; and he recommended not to purchase the In-forms. Mr. Weldon is working together with District VII; which has already put together a package of forms to be reviewed. This package includes utility relocation schedules and other various forms. Forms submitted to the Department must be in Word Perfect format, till further notice.

Mr. Ken Weldon stated that issues on the Utility Accommodation Manual, Utility Permit Re-Write, Pole Task Team (as on shown in priority order) are on hold until the current issues (reference to the survey form) are resolved.

Mr. Weldon informed the attendees that a situation was encountered on one of the District's construction project in which the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) had shut down the project because they do not like conflict manholes when water mains are involved. A couple of meetings were scheduled with FDEP to discuss and resolve this issues. Mr. Weldon encouraged representatives of utilities (water) to write to Mr.Greg Parker in the Drinking Water Division in Tallahassee at the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to express that conflict manholes are a necessary item in construction projects and let him know about your experience with conflict manholes. Mr Weldon also expressed his interest in knowing if any water utility has in fact had any problems with conflict manholes.

The new utility specifications and pay items are awaiting review by his office. One of the items begin pursued very vigorously at this time is providing training to the Maintenance and Construction Division staff on jack & bore, primarily directional bore.

GUEST SPEAKER - Mary-Jo Cooney, Esp., Sr Program Analyst - FDOT Office of Pipeline Safety

Ms. Cooney talked about the issue of third party damage, also known as outside force or excavation damage. She stated that education of the "public" about safety issues related to underground utilities is essential to reduce the incidence of third party damage. This type of "accidental hit" of an underground utility is a current and significant problem.

Ms. Cooney mentioned that the cornerstone of damage prevention is the One-Call System; however, even with this system there are certain limitations according to complaints received of locates not being accurate, etc... Ms. Cooney stated that is essential to educate the general public and professional excavators to use One-Call centers. Other measures to prevent hits of underground utilities is for utilities to have some type of damage prevention program using public service announcements, billboards, brochures, contractor awareness programs or inserts in the monthly bills to alert customers to the risks of excavating. Another measure is for utility agencies to locate their facilities accurately. Another one is "hand-digging", this clearly safe a life and avoid disruption of service. Subsurface Utility Engineering is another step towards prevention of utility damage, in most cases.

Ms. Cooney emphasized that not just one but a combination of the above preventive measures need to be utilized in order to avoid "accidental hits" of underground facilities.

The following were some of the reported information Ms. Cooney provided to the group:

- Most facility operators have been involved in accidental hits of underground utilities
- 88% of facilities are damaged by another entity/party
- 62% damaged by own agency/party
- 65% damaged another facility

Vice Chairman Pellico presented Ms. Cooney with a Speaker Award in appreciation for her informative presentation.

Ms. Arlene McGee presented the Liaison Person of the Year Award to Mark Sweet. Mark graduated from the University of Florida with BA in Political Science in 1977. He has a Masters Degree in Public Administration. '79 to '81 worked for the City of Seminole as the Assistant to the Mayor. '81 to '83 worked for the City of Treasure Island as the Assistant to the City Manager. '83 to '85 worked for Pinellas County. In 1985 he joined Florida Power Corp. Since 1994, he's being the Manager of the FPC's Distribution Facilities Utilization Department. He served as Secretary of the FUCC from 1990 to 1991, Vice-Chairman from 1991 to 1992, and became the FUCC Chairman 1992 to 1993. He served as the Conference Planner for three years and did a wonderful job for the Committee. Congratulations, Mark!!!

Vice-Chairman Pellico requested to all the FDOT District Engineers to provide the local chapter's utility coordinating Chairman's name in the report to be submitted to the FUCC secretary.

This year we are looking about a 16% to 20% increase. As of June 30, 1997 there were 435,025 notifications/tickets and in transmissions there were 2,762,828. Some legislation changes this year effective October 1, 1997; there is a newsletter available at the registration desk.

POWER - Chuck Easterling

There were 26 in attendance. The topics of discussion were as follows:

- Question/answer session with State Utility Engineer, Ken Weldon regarding 3R projects, Task Team issues, and U.A.M.

 - Criticality of relocation schedule compliance of penalties
 - Possible sharing of contractor bonuses with utilities

There were 22 members in attendance. There was an in-depth discussion on the status of the moratorium that Broward County and 26 of the 28 municipalities had placed on the communications industry. Ordinances were trying to be placed to inflict large fees for permits, additional cable placement, etc ... The cities and county are trying to get a new revenue source. Since other cities were looking at what is occurring here, it is definitely a great concern to the telecommunication service providers. At the present time, Broward County has tabled the effort on trying to pass an ordinance at this time.

MEMBERSHIP - Dan Boul

We will be increasing our mailing list over the next few months. It was requested that the District Liaison committees send mailing lists of their members to Dan Boul. Also inclusion of the FUCC meeting notice will be included in the One-Call news letter.

STEERING COMMITTEE - David Pellico

The Steering Committee had the End-of-the-Year discussion on all the existing subcommittees and their status. It was discussed that there was a need to create two new subcommittees; one for the Program Speaker Subcommittee and one for the FUCC Local District Utility Liaison subcommittee. Dennis LaBelle has graciously accepted to chair the Program

Another item discussed was the R/R and the changes they are trying to enforce on their rates. FEC is consolidating all the permit crossing in a county, and placing a flat fee on them, This fee is considerably higher than the individual ones, in total. Other members have experienced a similar situation with CSX. It was also mentioned by a FPL representative at the interest group meeting that they are in the condemnation process for some crossings and that it is a very time-consuming process.

UNDERGROUND - Rob Hudack

There were 24 in attendance. The topics discussed were as follows:

- Utility Accommodation Manual / Received proposed interim RRR utility offset design guidelines and reviewed for
 underground application. Individuals were concerned that opening paragraph would be conductive to further review
 by FUCC members prior to actual approval by FDOT and its implementation. Ken Weldon had indicated that if
 comments back to him were favorable; he could proceed to change UAM and schedule a workshop by the end of the
 year. Members urged to five feedback to FDOT by September 1.
- Subsurface Utility Engineering / Discussion was very interactive with the ovrall feeling that SUE should be used on all
 projects between the 30% & 60% plans as most effective in securing information as to actually where utilities are and
 saving monies by resolving what could be potential conflicts during actual work. District 2 representative spoke of
 many successes all around and the members present were informed that all districts have budgeted for this type of utility
 locating. It is suggested that each utility touch base with their DUE.
- Call Sunshine Changes in Law / Now all inclusive for membership as of October 1, 1997... Cities under 10,000 unincarcerated population could receive exemption. A hand digging exemption for members was also discussed. However, members are still liable for damage of another facility.
- New Underground Locating Course / It is being developed by Sunshine's Dan Boul, Hillsborough County's Brewster Technical Center, and Rob Hudack from Peoples Gas, predominantly geared to utility locators and contractors. The contractors to be assisted and educated will be the ones accountable for much of the damaged lines in the last few years. They are plumbers, irrigation, fence, nursery and landscape excavation contractors. A yellow survey form is available at the registration desk. - Placement of Tracing Wire on PVC Piping/ It was discussed the placement of tracing wire around a plastic pipe is not
 recommended due to a potential lightning hit and then the inevitable damage to the pipe occurring as a result of the
 impact. Placement of the wire adjacent to the pipeline was discussed as one way of placement; keeping in mind that
 pipeline has to be checked for continuity if damage to the wire has occurred.

SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

UAM / STANDARDS REVIEW - Tom Kennedy

The Subcommittee met on Thursday July 31, 1997, to review Mr. Weldon's proposal on 3R utility offset design guidelines. This proposal addresses a number of concerns raised in the May UAM Workshop.

The Subcommittee's 24 participants developed a response to the proposal which will be sent to FDOT and individual members are encouraged to respond individually as well. Future meetings will be scheduled in response to FDOT's progress on these issues.

JOINT USE - Bill Hetherington

No report at this time.

ELECTRONIC PERMITTING - Bill Hetherington

The Subcommittee met in June in Bartow and also met in July in Tallahassee. Currently conducting BETA testing of electronic on-line permitting system in FDOT District I (Bartow Maintenance Office)

Last month met with Leigh Gainous in Tallahassee to address their legal concerns as well as the use of software for this process; and no problems appear to be anticipated.

Speaker Subcommittee and Dan Boul has also graciously accepted to chair the FUCC Local District Utility Liaison Subcommittee. Congratulations Dennis and Dan!!! Other FUCC members' participation and involvement are greatly appreciated. At this time, Vice-Chairman now Chairman David Pellico re-established all of the existing subcommittees with the exception of the ADHOC and the MOT Plates subcommittees which at this time are abolished.
