von Trapp Bohemian Pilsner-VT

Pilsner. Spicy, citrus peel botanicals combine with a dry, peppery finish to create a truly thirst-quenching lager. 5.4% ABV \$5

Hamburg Apricot Cider-NY

Cider. Flavors of apple and apricot. 6% ABV \$6

Stella Artois-Belgium

Belgian Pale Lager. A medium bodied lager with tastes of citrus and malts. 5% ABV \$5

Big Ditch Hayburner-NY

India Pale Ale. Hayburner is a luscious and citrusy IPA, with primary notes of orange, melon, grapefruit, and a slightly earthy finish. 7% ABV \$5

Rohrbach Scotch Ale-Rochester, NY

Strong, full-bodied ale with a sweet caramel flavor, and a high alcohol content. This beer is much stronger than it tastes, but goes down smooth. ABV 7.0% \$5

Genesee Ruby Red Kolsch-Roch, NY

Kolsch. Crisp, bright-golden ale with a bready malt body and a mild hop bitterness that complement the perfect addition of tart, mouthwatering grapefruit. 4.5% ABV \$5

Abita Purple Haze-LA

Wheat Beer. Crisp, American style wheat beer with fresh raspberries added during secondary fermentation. Subtle coloration, fruity aroma and tartly sweet taste. 4.75% ABV \$5

New Belgium Fat Tire-CO

Amber Ale. Toasty malt flavors coasting in equilibrium with hoppy freshness. 5.2% ABV \$5

*Ommegang Three Philosophers-NY

Belgian Style Quad. A heavy beer with tastes of malt, cherry and raisins. 9.8% ABV \$7.50

Yuengling Traditional Lager-PA

Amber Lager. Famous for its rich amber color and medium-bodied flavor with a roasted caramel malt for a subtle sweetness. 4.4% ABV \$5

Thin Man Minkey Boodle-NY

Sour. Flavors of raspberry with a light tart finish. 7% ABV \$6

Downeast Cider-MA

Cider. Original blend. 5.1% ABV \$5

Blue Moon-CO

Belgian Style Witbier. Creaminess and spiced with the perfect combination of orange peel and coriander. 5.4% ABV \$5

Labatt Blue Light

Pale Lager. Crisp, clean and delicately balanced in it's flavor delivery. A hint of aromatic hop with slight sweetness and fruity character. 4% ABV \$5

Guinness-Ire

Ireland's famous stout. ABV 4.2% \$6 (200z)
