

Of the group, a military cross belt buckle found by Duane Carter was a particularly noteworthy one. The buckle, a brass one, was found with a Tesoro Toltec 100 at a Seminole Indian War fort site on the Suwannee River near Mayo, Florida. The fort was established in April 1839, and abandoned in November of 1842. The buckle in the form of a cross was found on Febuary 9, 1991.
