Tech Talk: Magnet Fishing

Most magnets are sufficiently powerful to



retrieve most objects. Use non-stretch, high strength paracord as your line. Do not jerk, use a continuously smooth, even pull while dragging your magnet back to shore.

Move magnets laterally

across item to remove it, or use a prybar. Lake bottoms are mucky, use gloves and change them often to prevent bacterial infections.

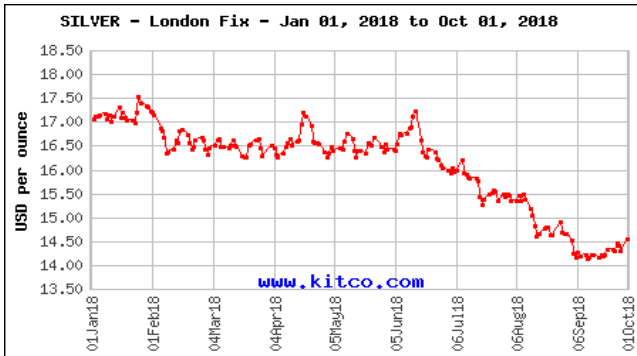
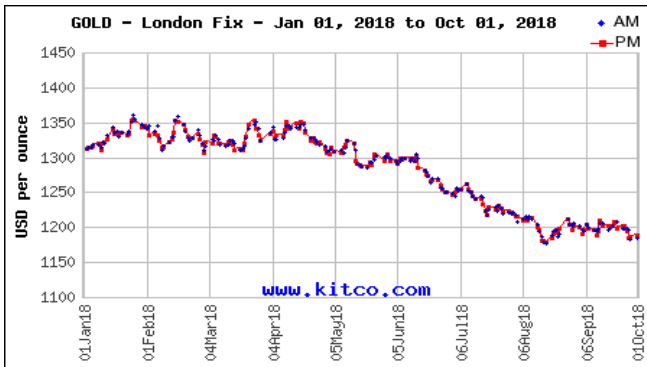

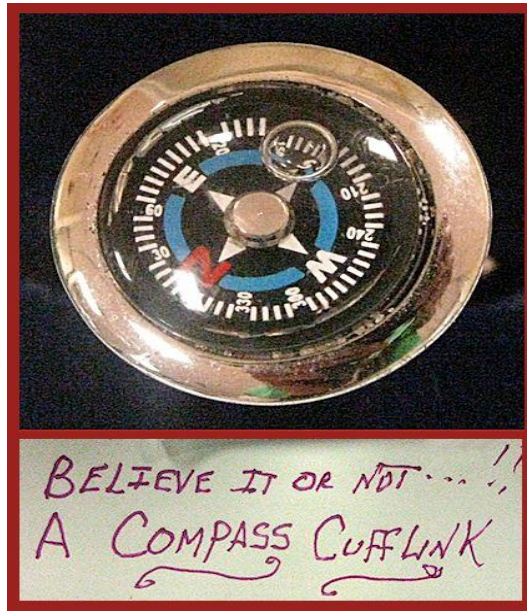
