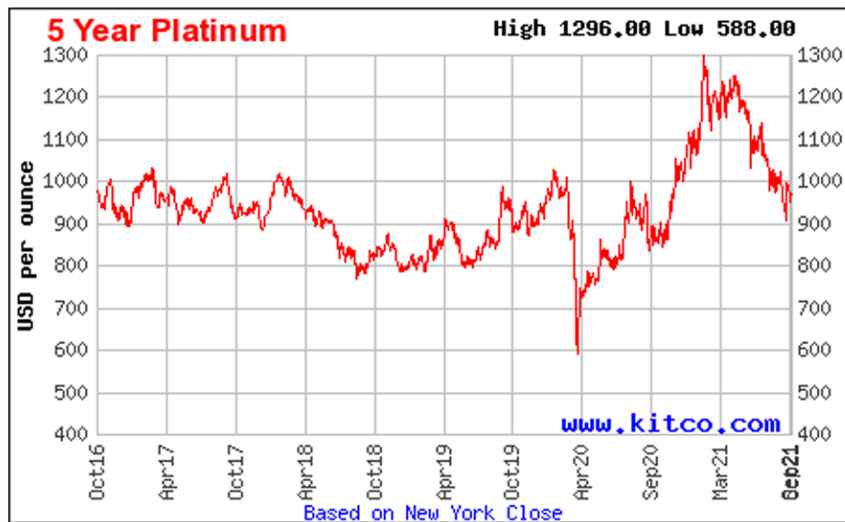
Code Of Ethics
