IF YOU ARE UNSURE WHEN YOUR VACATION WILL BE, PLEASE SEE THE OFFICE FOR INSTRUCTIONS.** Weekly field trips may be changed due to scheduling conflicts with the field trip provider, weather, illness, or other factors beyond our control. **NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN DUE TO FIELD TRIP CHANGES.** The canceled trip will be replaced with another event.

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Fee Policy and Procedure

1. A non-refundable program registration fee (\$80.00 for non-Smart after-schoolers applicants and \$60.00 for current '23-'24 school term after-schoolers) is due at registration **ALONG WITH** the fee for the **FIRST** week of camp. Payment for subsequent weeks is due **Monday** one week in advance of intended dates. Tuition is \$225.00 per week. No discount will be given for trips not attended.
2. **Spaces are not guaranteed until completed application forms; registration fee and the first-week camp fee are submitted.** Advanced multiple-week payments are welcomed. There is no refund of camp fees for unused days or weeks. Since space is limited, you are obligated to pay for all weeks for which your child is registered. **Our camp's budget is based upon full enrollment; therefore, compensation cannot be given for absences due to illness or any other reason.** Family discounts for multiple children are not effective for summer camp due to the pricing of field trips and fuel.
3. Fees are due on **Monday** of each week in advance of the next scheduled week of camp. There is a \$10.00 charge assessed if payment is not received by **Wednesday** of the current camp week. Fees may be placed in the payment drop box located on the office door. **WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE A CAMPER WHOSE CAMP FEES ARE NOT CURRENT.**
4. A \$35.00 service fee will be charged for all returned checks. (If the bank service charge is higher, the higher rate will prevail.)
5. Late Pickup Fee - Smart Start Summer Camp closes promptly at 6:00 p.m., late fees for campers are as follows: \$1.00 per family per minute.
6. Children will be released only to persons authorized by parents or guardians as listed on the enrollment form. All persons picking up children should carry Picture Identification as it will be required if that person is not known by the staff on site. Other procedures may be arranged but must be in writing and on file.
7. Camp T-Shirts must be worn on **All FIELD TRIPS** if your child is not wearing his/her assigned shirt, a second shirt will be issued, and a \$12.00 charge will be billed to your account.
8. Field Trip Departure times will be posted on the Camp Field Trip Schedule. **Please make sure your child is present at least 30 minutes prior to departure.** Staff will be assessing transportation needs along with the appropriate number of chaperones, seating arrangement, and general gathering of safety information necessary to ensure a safe and fun trip. When children arrive late it disrupts the orderly preparation for leaving the building. The children are late loading the van, the van is late arriving at the destination, and we risk losing the field trip.
9. Smart Start's policy for **MOVIES** is as follows: All movies viewed by students will be either **G** or **PG** rated. It is not possible to post viewings in advance, so we ask that you inform the Directors if there are any movies you do not want your children to see.
10. Dress Code: Sneakers or closed-toe shoes only. **GIRLS:** shorts under dresses or skirts. **BOYS:** belts if pants are prone to drop below the waist.
11. Personal Property: Smart Start encourages children to leave all portable electronic devices including cell phones at home. We will not be responsible for any lost, misplaced, broken, or stolen monies or personal property. If any items are brought in, please make sure a bag or backpack if provided and **EVERYTHING** is labeled.

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CODE OF CONDUCT

Smart Start's goal is to offer a safe and enriching experience for all students. Reasonable rules and regulations are essential to ensure the safety of each child. This gives the student the opportunity to experience full enjoyment of our program.

The following is the CODE OF CONDUCT. PLEASE REVIEW WITH YOUR CHLD.

1. Student must stay with staff member in assigned activity area or room and must have consent from the staff member to go to another area.
2. Students must show courtesy, respect, and good manners toward fellow students and staff members.
3. Student must use appropriate language, NO profane or inappropriate language or gestures.
4. Students must keep hands and feet to themselves. No kicking or hitting; No Fighting.
5. Student must be respectful of property belonging to Smart Start and fellow campers. Parent or Guardian will be responsible for payment of any damaged or destroyed property.
6. Good Sportsmanship and fair play must be displayed at all times.
7. Violent toys or instruments will not be allowed on the premises.

The following are the VAN/TRANSPORTATION RULES.

Student must remain seated and have seat belt buckled at all times.

Student will speak at a level where only the person sitting next to him/her can hear unless speaking with the driver or patrol.

When loading Student will not approach the van until the Driver has stopped and has opened the door.

When exiting, Student will sit quietly until the motor is off and the driver has opened the door. Exit from the first row of seats first, second row, etc., or as the driver directs.

Campers will sit in assigned seats if the Driver appoints assigned seats.

FAILURE TO OBEY THE ABOVE RULES MAY RESULT IN THE FOLLOWING PROGRESSION OF DISCIPLINARY ACTION:

Step 1: Verbal Reprimand

Step 2: Verbal Reprimand

Step 3: Time Out which may result in loss of completion of activity

Step 4: Written Notice which Parent must sign and loss of Field Trip

Step 5: Parent Conference may be scheduled, and camper may be suspended from program.

Any behavior that is deemed malicious or violent or results in physical and/or property damage may result in immediate expulsion from the program.

Smart Start reserves the right to implement any of the above steps deemed necessary, based upon the severity of the behavior. Extreme situations will be referred to Smart Start Executive Directors, followed by a conference with the parent and/or guardian and the student.

PARENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made between Smart Start and myself to verify that I have read the Registration information, Code of Conduct from and the Fee Policy and Procedures form and fully understand my obligations regarding the following:

- Age of children attending; registration, advance tuition payment requirements.
- late fees, and all additional fees; arrival and departure procedures.
- T-shirt requirement; and the Student Code of Conduct.

FIELD TRIP AND MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION

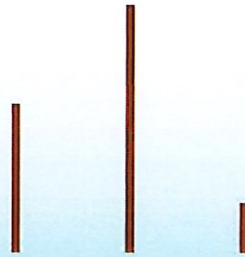

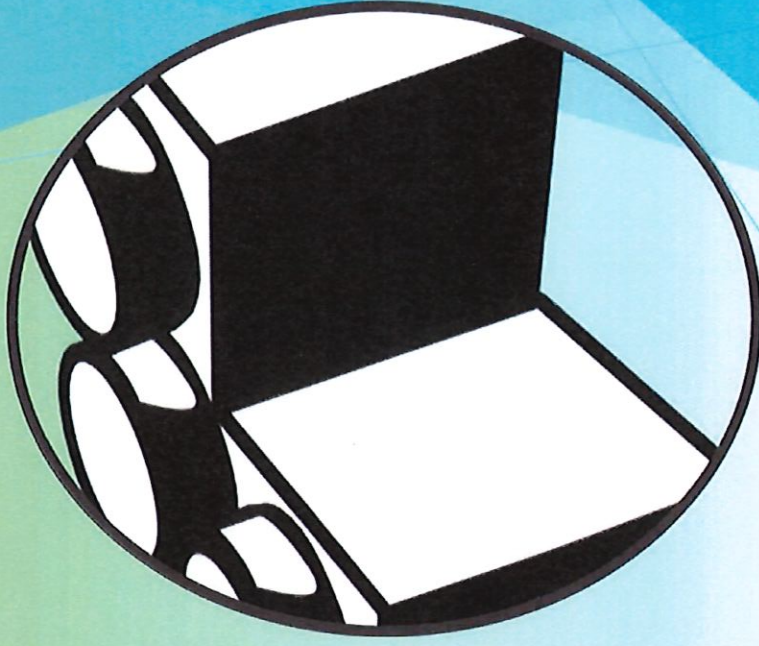
