Pastor's Notes

A man after God's own heart. That is what God said about David, of David and Goliath fame. David rose to prominence after he defeated Goliath, the warrior champion of the Philistines. He was anointed the future king of Israel at the young age of 14 but he didn't receive that position till he was 30. Between the age of 14-30, David went through many trials, trials that helped make him fit to be a King.

Paul, speaking of David in Acts 13, recorded this of David. (God said)"... I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do." And it was true. David did do the things God wanted him to do when God wanted him to do them and in the way God wanted it to be done...mostly.

Like all people, David was human which meant he had flaws which meant he made mistakes. The biggest of which was his adulterous affair with Bathsheba and the killing of her husband to try and cover it up. In our standards today, this is a pretty big flaw. Life was certainly different in the days of David, murder was a severe crime, but if you were a king of a vast domain, chances are you could get away with it. Nobody knew and nobody was going to point out to the king he sinned right? Nobody but a man of God named Nathan.

God wasn't going to allow sin to stay unrevealed in David's heart, after all God knew how much David loved Him. so God revealed to the prophet Nathan what David had done.

In Psalm 51 David confesses...vs. 14, "Against You, You only I have sinned and done what is evil in Your sight. So that You are justified when You speak and blameless when You judge." And judge God did. You can read about the consequences of David's sin. God grieved over David's fall but He also grieved over the loss of His name.

2 Samuel 12:14, "However, because by this deed you have given occasion to the enemies of the Lord to blaspheme (to despise and reject Me, God)..." This is what happens when we sin. Hopefully, by the grace of God, when your sin comes to light you confess it before the Lord. But there are nearly always consequences to our sins. Not only for us but for all those around us. If our sin is in the public eye, people around you who know you go to church and proclaim Christ as your Savior, they begin to wonder about you, God and your relationship with God. They wonder if you really believe what you confess. They wonder if you really believe there is a God. God's name has been blasphemed. Not a place we want to go right?

David's confession in Psalm 51 continues with words like, wash me, cleanse me, purify me, create a clean heart within me and renew a steadfast spirit within me. (steadfast to be true to You and not sin again. This is true repentance) David also asks to have the joy of his salvation restored to him. And this is what God will do when we seek His forgiveness from a pure heart.

Our God is a loving, patient and forgiving God but it is His desire that we serve Him in a pure and upright way, seeking, with Christ's help, to live a holy and pure life. And when we do, this is the greatest place of joy we can experience. Peace with our God puts peace within our hearts. I hope you are experiencing the peace that is beyond anything this world has to offer. If you experience falls like David (not as grievous I'm sure) learn from David. Confess, go and sin no more.
