The Primary Election is over; however, the Special Election for Kevin McCarthy's remaining term is still going on. Election Day for

that particular race (CD20) is on March 19th. You were mailed an envelope with yellow on the left hand side. That is for the special election. Please make sure to vote! You have over a week! So far Measure 1 looks like it might be a Yes, Measure E failed, Measure A passed, and Measure B failed locally. Following the Flood, the Genesis account narrates the rise of a secular society apart from God, initiated by Nimrod, a descendant of Ham. Nimrod established the first secular government in Babel (Genesis 10:8-10) and expanded its influence to other cities, (Micah 5:5-6). introducing a system where a select few at the top benefited from the labor of the majority beneath them.

This exploitative principle, entwined with economic manipulation, has persisted throughout history, resulting in the formation of nations and empires characterized by rulers seeking wealth and power through aggression.

The governing principles of this Babylonian-style rule, marked by competition, strife, greed, and pride, have endured across various forms of human governments. Regardless of the specific administration, the core of human government is rooted in the exploitation of people and resources, wielded through power, aggression, and deception. The foundational concept of cramming people into cities has perpetuated a global order defined by strife and competition, where the political, economic, religious, and social facets of civilization vie for dominance.

The Bible suggests that this entire system, marked by confusion and conflict, is not aligned with God's design (James 3:16),. While governments have risen and fallen, the underlying principles of exploitation and competition have endured, fosterina confusion throughout the world. In contrast, God is depicted as a source of order, not confusion, highlighting (I Corinthians 14:33). the disparity between the world's system government and God's intended design.

Based on this information there are many Christians and leaders who have come to the conclusion that it is wrong to participate in a process that is historically evil. However there is more to the story; Jesus went about doing good. (even to a fallen and evil world). Christians are, or should be involved in the process of spiritual growth and development, and that includes developing spiritual intelligence and decrement (Proverbs 4:7 "Wisdom is principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding.").

The New Testament imparts teachings on submitting to authorities

within the Church, recognizing the challenging backdrop of corrupt authorities.

Under certain
circumstances, Christians
may find themselves
unable to comply with the
state if its commands
contradict God's
directives or vice versa,
as underscored in Acts
4:19 and 5:29. The
exemplary life of Jesus
Christ underscores that
Christians may encounter
persecution and injustice
in their earthly journey.

All earthly judgments are provisional, with ultimate justice to be dispensed by God in a manner that will render every mouth silent and hold the entire world accountable to Him (Romans 3:19). The Bible conveys the notion that human beings are destined to face judgment after death, with this judgment based on their deeds during their earthly existence. This judgment, distinct from justification secured through Jesus Christ's atoning death on the cross, emphasizes the significance of one's actions in this life.

In a democratic setting, Christians possess the opportunity to serve as salt and light, utilizing their democratic rights for the advancement of the Gospel. The argument that the law should not enforce morality is often misapplied to Christians, who contend that morality cannot be divorced from the law. While secularists advocate for their assumptions to shape laws and policies, Christians maintain that national laws should function to restrain evil, aligning with God's moral law as articulated in the Bible.

The belief that the Bible contains the "Maker's instructions" underscores Christians' conviction that God's moral law is the ultimate safeguard and promoter of what is good for humanity. Advocating for public policies consistent with Christ's teachings and the Ten Commandments aligns with the desire to bring glory to God and pursue the best for people. In a democracy, Christians have the freedom to articulate their positions, speaking up for what is right while recognizing that individuals have the liberty to accept or reject these perspectives.

The motivation for Christians to speak out is rooted in love for their neighbors and the earnest desire for their wellbeing. In this endeavor, Christians may find resonance with non-Christians, as the innate conscience in humanity, albeit fallen, can still align with God's standards (Romans 2:14-15).
