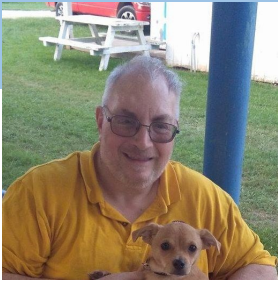

- 6. Time of Day** -blood sugar can be harder to control the later it gets.
- 7. Dawn Phenomenon**-people have a surge in hormones early in the morning whether they have diabetes or not. People with diabetes, blood sugar can spike.
- 8. Dehydration**-less water in your blood means your blood sugar is more concentrated.
- 9. Nose spray**-Some have chemicals that trigger your liver to make more blood sugar.
- 10. Gum disease**-its both a complication of diabetes and blood sugar spikes.

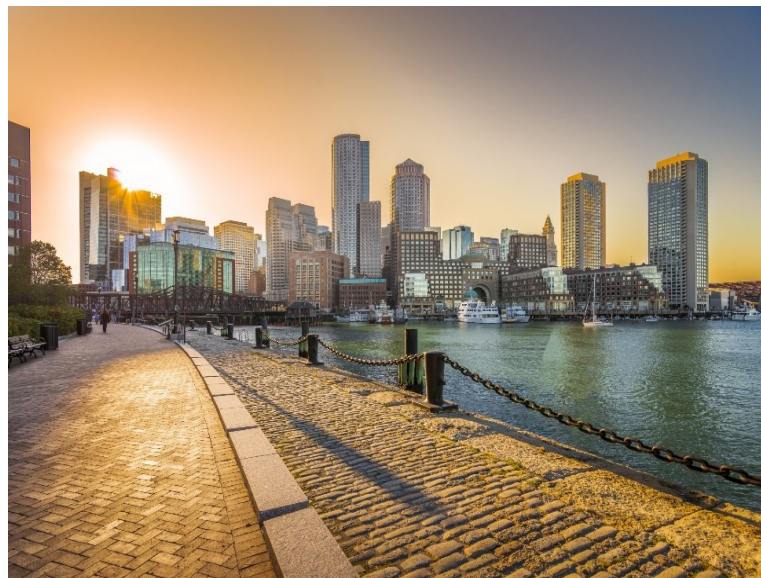
