4. Completed pulling wire from dewatering bldg. to east storage for AMT sludge pump
5. Dug out cut concrete east of office (to add sludge valve) and by west gate entrance (to widen for sludge hauling) with mini-excavator; set forms for drive widening and added/compacted stone; tied in rebar
6. Called Republic Services and scheduled pickup for next day. Also, confirmed that Special Waste Permit for grit/grease/screenings for Celina Landfill was transferrable since Celina Landfill was closing. Received call back confirming that our Special Waste would now go to Carey Landfill and that Republic Services was changing Manifest forms to reflect change
