Treasurer Report: Shannon Dietrick

- For far this year: Concessions had a net positive of \$4,000; School Store has broken even; Book sale earned \$16,000; Banners raised \$2,000; 'Membership raised about \$10,000; Mulch should probably come in at \$45,000
- Donated \$2,000 to Kennedy High School Athletics
- Next year Boosers needs to push for more donations
