



Someone You Know May Be Missing Out?

We need your help!!

Do you know retired teachers who wonder why they never hear from the chapter by email or printed mail? They may be members of the STS Health plan, but never hear from us at all. Please ask them to check either with our Membership Committee: Barb Alberton or Janet Lowndes, or the provincial office, to be sure they are on our membership list. This fall, for whatever reason, we have had several new retirees who were stuck in the limbo of non-chapter status. Fees are the same - they just are not attached to a local chapter.

Important Group Benefit Reminder

A reminder to all STS members who have recently retired or are leaving another Group Benefit Plan of the sixty-day window to join the STS Group Benefits Plan—the Extended Health Plan including travel and/or the Dental Plan--without having to provide medical evidence of good health. It is possible to join later but you will be asked to provide medical evidence. This same sixty-day window also applies to the spouse of a deceased superannuate or of a deceased active teacher who is then able to become a member of STS and apply to join the STS Group Benefit Plan without having to provide medical evidence of good health.
