



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT APD TESTING

Before Testing

1. Make sure your child gets plenty of sleep the night before their appointment.
2. Feed your child a healthy breakfast the morning of testing.
3. Bring copies of any previous testing (i.e., Audiology, psychology, school IEP, etc.)
4. Please contact your insurance company to verify your benefits for APD testing and understand your financial responsibility prior to testing. **We are out of network for all insurance companies**, but we can provide a detailed superbill that you can file with your insurance. Below is the information you may need:

5. Our fee for APD testing - \$650.00.
Many times, our fee is less than your out-of-pocket expense when going through insurance. We highly recommend you check with your insurance carrier.
6. Please notify us of a cancellation or need to reschedule with 24 hours' notice so that we may be able to offer that appointment to another family. Failure to do so will result in a \$100 cancellation fee. Exceptions will be considered for illness. Please do not bring a sick child for their appointment.

During Testing

1. Bring a water bottle and a snack for breaks.
2. Prepare for your child to stay 2 - 3 hours to complete testing. Breaks will be provided as needed.
3. For parents:
 - Please leave other siblings at home and plan to stay for the entire session.
 - Bring an activity to keep your child occupied for the last 30 minutes of the appointment so that you can maximize your counseling time with the audiologist and fully understand the impressions from the testing.
 - A full report will be mailed to you via a secure website.
