

Foundation Class Important Information

The Agility Dog Club of Victoria (ADCV) offers a 6-week Agility Foundation Course which is designed to teach you and your dog the basics of Agility. Training is held on Wednesday evenings at Crofts Reserve in Altona North.

We run 3 Foundation Classes each year (usually in February, April and August) and only allow a maximum of 10 dogs per intake. This is to ensure that both the dogs and their handlers (you) get the most out of the 6-week course.

Your dog(s) must meet the following requirements to be accepted into our Foundation class:

- Be at least 10 months old;
- Be able to pass our Pre-Foundation Assessment, which involves:
 - Watching your dog's reaction to many other dogs. This is a high arousal situation for many dogs.
 - Testing your dog's recall – he/she must have a solid recall with distractions (e.g. other dogs and people).
 - Seeing if your dog's collar can be held by an instructor.
 - A Sit-Stay activity – they must be able to sit and stay while you walk away from them and come when called.
- Be fully vaccinated and registered with your local council.

You **MUST** attend and pass our Pre-Foundation Assessment Day before we accept you into our course. The course is designed to teach you the fundamentals of agility, not obedience.

Assessment Days are run throughout the year, and following the submission of your form, you will be contacted by an ADCV member to book into a session. If you cannot attend the upcoming Assessment Days, you will not be able to commence.
