I have a couple of things to share.

- Leagues at both courses will be able to start playing at 8:00 AM effective the first Wednesday and Thursday of June. That time will can stay in effect through August.
- 2. At Pine Lakes you will see some paint around the 18th green and the 14th green. The paint on18 indicates where the new edge of the green will be. Scotty is extending the size of that green. You will begin to see it cut accordingly. The paint on hole 14 is to indicate where the new approach will be cut to. There may be some changes like this at Lake Fairways. Scotty and I will be driving around Lake Fairways this afternoon.
- Also, there are going to be yellow tees added to both Pine Lakes and Lake Fairways. These will be in place of pink tees. We are unable to purchase tee

markers in pink so we will go with yellow. This will not be on every hole. They were laid out at Pine Lakes this morning and will be laid out at Lake Fairways this afternoon.

- Based on how the tee sheets have been looking and course usage I am going to move up the closing time of the pro shops at 2:00 from June 1st to May 1st.
- 5. Here is how the new hours will look

Lake Fairways (M-Sun 7-2) May 1st - May 31st (M-Sun 7-12) June 1st- Aug 31st

The reason Pine Lakes will not go to noon closing is because all of the staff at Pine Lakes are full-time and must maintain a certain amount of hours per week.
