

## MATCH PLAY ETIQUETTE

...You and your opponent can flip a coin to decide who tees off first OR the lower seed can tee off first.

...After completing the first hole, the person who has won that hole has honors to tee off first on the next hole. This courtesy continues throughout the match.

...IMPORTANT!!! In match play, the player who is farthest away from the hole ALWAYS hits first. You can be on the green and farthest from the hole...your opponent can be off the green but closer to the hole. Farthest away always plays first. If you go out of turn your opponent may ask you to rehit when it is your turn. No penalty.

...IMPORTANT!!! You always mark your ball. You NEVER ask if you can putt out or finish play. Your opponent may give you a putt if it is very close to the hole...but if she doesn't give you the putt...MARK YOUR BALL and wait your turn.

...If your opponent is very close to the hole and you think she can make the putt...please concede the putt.

...At any time you feel you are out of the hole (you have more strokes than your opponent).. please concede the hole—There is absolutely no reason to continue play if your opponent is already in the hole with a lesser stroke number than you.

...You may at any time, ask your opponent how many strokes she has taken. She is obliged to answer you with her stroke total. This will give you an idea whether you are still in the hole or you have already lost it—

...Do not stand in anyone's line

...Do not interfere in anyone

...If you and your opponent have unresolved questions, please call rules person before you leave the hole.

...You always have control of your own ball. If you are on the green and want to mark your ball, you may do so at any time.
