We have. We stand on Jesus Christ. There is salvation in no one else and there is no other name given under heaven whereby people can be saved.

"No – I mean you have to take a stand when it comes to opening or closing and masking or not masking and pro-vaccination or anti-vaccination."

No, I don't have to take a stand on those things. The church I serve will serve those who have differing opinions and convictions on all those matters.

- You don't set the narrative for the Church Jesus does.
- You don't set the imperatives for the Church Jesus does.
- You don't set the agenda for the Church Jesus does.
- The mission, mandate, and message of the Church comes from Jesus and not from some think tank somewhere.

I cannot depart from the narrative, the imperatives, and the agenda of Jesus to serve your small vision. I cannot depart from the mission, mandate, and message of the Jesus to serve your narrow vision.

"Well, don't you have opinions and convictions when it comes to these matters?"

Yes, I do. And I will stand by them. But the only thing I will stand on is the salvation that is found in Christ and in Christ alone. I will not let any of those things, and a thousand others, define what the Church of Jesus is. The Church of Jesus Christ serves maskers and anti-maskers, vaccers and anti-vaccers, Democrats and Republicans. I want to be known for our stand on eternal matters and not the cultural issues of the day. I want to be known for declaring the salvation that is in Jesus Christ and not for being a champion for the cultural cause of the day.
