

What is the Spectacular Juneteenth Cultural Celebration

The Juneteenth Cultural Celebration supported in part by the City of Franklin is the first of an annual five-year plan to create a national tourist destination event in the location of the County that played such a significant role in both slavery and the emancipation that Juneteenth celebrates. The Juneteenth Cultural Celebration is a three-day event June 17th 18th and concluding on June 19th. By design it is created to be larger, grander, and longer than any other Juneteenth celebration in the nation in pursuing our goal to create a national tourist destination in Southampton County dedicated to capitalizing on our rich emancipation history.

In celebrating Juneteenth with our cultural celebration, we want to present a different narrative to one of Southampton's own Nat Turner. For over a century the deeds of Nat Turner, who was known worldwide, has been cast in an extremely negative light. In a population of millions of enslaved people and abolitionists, he was seen as a hero and a freedom fighter. Comparative to how Andrew Jackson was seen by the native tribes of America.

Juneteenth celebrates the unique culture of African Americans and all Americans that can embrace emancipation of an abused people simply for great profit. African Americans have thrived in creating many of the American traditions that are synonymous to the United States in many ways not the least being music and fashions. Juneteenth is not just an African American holiday, its an American holiday celebrating culture, unity, conquest over evil and national pride. Juneteenth is our cultural celebration and Virginia Mardi Gras.



1st Annual Juneteenth Fashion Show

The first annual Juneteenth Fashion show is the efforts of the producer Naomi Dawson of "All in modeling agency. Naomi reigns from New York City by way of Norfolk, Virginia and has been along with her associates in the fashion industry for decades. Naomi also known as "Faith Grace" works with all ages and includes people who have a passion and desire to be in the business of modeling and fashion. Faith will grace the Juneteenth Cultural Celebration with an all-inclusive approach to celebrate her passion with and the passion that African Americans culturally have always embraced. This will possibly be the first fashion show held in the newly renovated Hayden Village, a contribution by the Senior Services of Southeastern Virginia. Hayden was originally built back in the fifties as Hayden High school a segregated school exclusively for African American students who were not allowed to attend school with white children. Closed after a little more than one decade the school ended up abandoned due to integration. But, not before educating African American children that would go on to become doctors, lawyers, judges, and all sorts of professionals. Named after Della Hayden an advocate for the development of African American women, Hayden village is a fitting location for the first annual Juneteenth fashion show. While this is our first year of this annual celebration and fashion show we know you will enjoy the efforts of Miss Naomi Dawkins and the Juneteenth Cultural Celebration to highlight yet another cultural aspect of the emancipation of an enslaved people to grow stronger and better each year. This fashion show concept would not be complete without mentioning Miss Marie Antionette for her much-appreciated input into the concept of adding a fashion show to the Juneteenth Cultural Celebration.

Black History Program

A brief description of the origins of the black history program as a part of the Juneteenth Cultural Celebration. The planning was just about complete for our first annual Juneteenth Cultural Celebration when one of my constituents called me and told me he heard about the line up for the event and asked, "why weren't we including a black history program as a part of the event"? I informed him that "I thought the entire event being a Juneteenth Cultural Celebration was a black history program, not just another festival". That's when he said "he was referring to some sort of black history program with people speaking on local historical events and black history". So, I said "you're right, how would you like to present a black history program as a part of the Juneteenth Cultural Celebration"? He agreed and with little assistance Mr. Evans began to orchestrate and coordinate the first black history program as a part of the Juneteenth Cultural Celebration. With the support of senior services of southeastern Virginia, I was able to secure the historically restored Hayden Village, formally an abandoned segregated high school to present the

program. It will include speakers that are both historians like Dr. Joyce White-Tasby to modern black history makers like Sheriff Josh Wyche the first African American Sheriff in Southampton Va. the birthplace of Nat Turner and home of the largest insurrection to slavery in American history. Along with more guest both singing and teaching on many black history subjects, including Jessy speaking on Della Hayden. We are proud to present our first black history program as a part of our first annual Juneteenth Cultural Celebration all thanks to Mr. Jessy Evans for his contribution.

Nat Turner Story Tour

The Nat Turner Story tour is designed to take a shot at changing the traditional American narrative of a brutal killer to the reality of a man who gave his life trying to bring an end to the worst form of human slavery that civilization has ever known. Nat Turner born right here in Southampton County and is known throughout the entire world by most civilized and educated people for his 1831 insurrection and rebellion to emancipate and bring an end to the slavery of African American born slaves in the United States. The brutality and brutal acts he was accused of committing pales in comparison to the horrific acts of inhumanity and violence that was legalized against an entire race of people, whose sole existence was to serve and literally take care of. The most ironic portion of the American Nat Turner narrative is that he himself never actually killed anyone, his men and comrades did the killing under his command. If we refuse to correct the distorted inaccurate history now while we can the truth will remain untold and distorted. Another lie the American history narrative tells is the inaccurate description that he is portrayed as a dark skinned animalistic looking individual. In fact, he was what was referred to as a mulatto of mixed black and white race. The main thing that makes our Nat Turner Story Tour so unique and special is that there are 5 stops on the tour that are all hosted by direct descendants of Nat Turner's bloodline. All but one stop on the tour is on the exact land where Nat Turner was born, lived, hid out and traveled. A special event that makes our Juneteenth truly a cultural event and celebration unlike any other in the country. This event would not have been possible without the help and support of Ms. Shelly Lucas Wood and the other blood descendants of the Nat Turner.





Shelly Wood closer resembles the complexion and facial structure of Nathanial "Nat" Turner, there are no pictures or body to be exhumed for identification or DNA because of the inhumane and heinous method the white citizens decapitated and dilapidated his remains. Only his skull remains in the care of the Smithsonian Institute who confirmed Shelly's family DNA. Great appreciation and thanks go out to the entire family of blood descendants of the great Nathanial Turner family for their cooperation to allow the public onto these sacred family grounds that have never opened to the public.



Cornhole Tournament

Not quite an Olympic sport yet. One of the newest and fastest growing sports to take hold across America is the game of cornhole. You have probably seen it played in the back yards, at a family gathering, or at any number of venues in your area. What makes cornhole so popular is the fact that almost anyone can play. Cornhole is a game in which players or teams take turns throwing fabric beanbags at a raised, angled board with a hole in its far end. The boards are 27 feet apart from front to front. The goal of the game is to score points by either landing a bag on the board (one point) or putting a bag through the hole (three points). Sounds simple enough but it takes skill and teamwork to win. The reason cornhole has been selected to be a part of The Spectacular Juneteenth Cultural Celebration is the ease of play, and the fact that it can bring all kinds of people together to have a great time together.


