From Rev. Haydie

Welcome spring! The mountains around us are finally green, and the lilacs and chokecherries are blooming on almost every street. When better to begin the church's "long green season"? Our vestments and altar hangings will change to green in early June. They'll stay that way until Advent—long after the hills around us have turned back to brown and even white.

To our Roman Catholic friends, these months are "Ordinary Time." We've finished this year's telling of Jesus's birth, death, resurrection, and ascension. We can focus on his teachings now. We can reflect on how his life and teachings have shaped our ordinary lives. How they *might* shape our ordinary lives.

And we never reflect alone. *Our* tradition calls these months the "season after Pentecost." That name reminds us, every week, of the great wind that swept through the room where the disciples were praying. Of the Spirit that filled them. Of the joy that filled them when they realized that God was still with them to guide, comfort, and protect them—just as God guides and comforts and protects us.

The disciples' experience of the Spirit—of God's love and God's presence—shaped the rest of their lives. That day knit them into community, encouraged them to take risks, and sent them out to serve the world in Jesus's name. It drew them ever closer to God, blessing all their ordinary days.

May your ordinary days, too, be blessed ones!
